Description of Facility	Millennium Bulk Terminals proposes to construct and operate a coal export terminal in Longview, Washington. The terminal will receive coal via railroad and stockpile material onsite. Stored coal will be loaded to marine vessels for shipment overseas.		
Source Designation	Minor. The facility is a stationary source subject to review under SWCAA 400-110.
