Affected Facility	Vancouver School District 16100 NE 50 th Avenue Vancouver, WA 98661
Description of Facility	Vancouver School District has built a new three story 78,000 square foot school called Itech Preparatory, The school serves 700 students in grades 6 through 12. The campus exists on land owned by Washington State University Vancouver. Emission generating equipment consists of two boilers, three water heaters, and an emergency generator.
Source Designation	Minor The facility is a stationary source subject to review under SWCAA 400-110. Facility emissions will be less than 100 tpy of any single criteria pollutant, less than 10 tpy of any single hazardous air pollutant, and less than 25 tpy of any combination of hazardous air pollutants.
Purpose of Application	SWCAA has received a permit application for installed equipment consisting of two boilers, three water heaters, and a generator. The application has not yet been reviewed to determine if it is administratively complete. The SWCAA permit writer identified below will be reviewing the application to make a determination of completeness and, if necessary, make a request for additional information.
Affected Pollutants	The proposed permitting action is expected to impact emissions of the following pollutants: Nitrogen Oxides (NO _x), Carbon Monoxide (CO), Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC), Sulfur Dioxide (SO ₂), Particulate Matter (PM), Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs) and Toxic Air Pollutants (TAPs)
