Affected Facility	Vancouver Ford Inc. 6801 NE 40 th Street Vancouver, WA 98661
Description of Facility	The permitted facility is the auto body shop operated by Vancouver Ford. The permittee operates a paint mixing room, a surface preparation area, a heated paint spray booth, and a spray liner booth.
Source Designation	<u>Minor</u> The facility is a stationary source subject to review under SWCAA 400-110. Facility emissions are less than 100 tpy of any single criteria pollutant, less than 10 tpy of any single hazardous air pollutant, and less than 25 tpy of any combination of hazardous air pollutants.
Purpose of Application	SWCAA has received a permit application for operation of an existing spray liner booth at the above-described facility. The application has not yet been reviewed to determine if it is administratively complete. The SWCAA permit writer identified below will be reviewing the application to make a determination of completeness and, if necessary, make a request for additional information. A copy of the application will be available to the public when the application is determined to be complete.
Affected Pollutants	The proposed permitting action is expected to impact emissions of the following pollutants: NO _x , CO, PM, VOC, SO ₂ , HAPs, TAPs
