Affected Facility	Pacific Coast Shredding 901 Port Way Vancouver, WA 98660
Description of Facility	Metal Shredding Facility
Source Designation	<u>Synthetic Minor</u> The facility is a stationary source subject to review under SWCAA 400-110. Facility emissions will be less than 100 tons per year (tpy) of any single criteria pollutant, less than 10 tpy of any single hazardous air pollutant, and less than 25 tpy of any combination of hazardous air pollutants.
Purpose of Application	SWCAA has received a permit application to limit the total number of vehicles shredded at the above location in order to reduce potential emissions below the relevant thresholds for an Air Operating Permit under WAC 173-401 and Title V of the federal Clean Air Act. The application has not yet been reviewed to determine if it is administratively complete. The SWCAA permit writer identified below will be reviewing the application to make a determination of completeness and, if necessary, make a request for additional information. A copy of the application will be available to the public when the application is determined to be complete.
Affected Pollutants	The proposed permitting action is expected to impact emissions of the following pollutants: Volatile organic compounds, hazardous air pollutants, and toxic air pollutants
Public Comment Period	A 30 day public comment period on the draft permit will be provided for this application pursuant to SWCAA 400-171(3). When complete, a copy of the draft permit will be made available at the SWCAA business office and posted on the SWCAA webpage under the "Permits and Appeals/Open for Public Comment" section at https://www.swcleanair.gov/permits/publiccomments.asp .

A public hearing will be held if the Control Officer determines that significant public interest exists.
