Affected Facility	Cowlitz Valley Compost 90 Tennant Way, Longview, WA 98632	
Description of Facility	Cowlitz Valley Compost operates a green waste composting facility. The composting facility will processes up to 70,000 cubic yards per year of green waste using an extended aerated static pile with biofilter layer. Various pieces of diesel engine driven equipment are used to transfer and size raw material and finished compost.	
Source Designation	<u>Minor</u> . The facility is a stationary source subject to review under SWCAA 400-110. Facility emissions are less than 100 tpy of any single criteria pollutant, less than 10 tpy of any single hazardous air pollutant, and less than 25 tpy of any combination of hazardous air pollutants.	
Purpose of Application	SWCAA has received a permit application for operation of a new diesel engine driven horizontal grinder and deck screen at the above described facility. The application has not yet been reviewed to determine if it is administratively complete. The SWCAA permit writer identified below will be reviewing the application to make a determination of completeness and, if necessary, make a request for additional information. A copy of the application will be available to the public when the application is determined to be complete.
