This preliminary determination modifies existing approval conditions for a wood fired fluid heater at a plywood mill located at 143 Maurin Road in Chehalis, Lewis County, Washington. The modified approval conditions extend the allowed time period during which visible emission limits are suspended for routine cold starts of the fluid heater. This action does not include the installation of new equipment, an increase in emission limits, or an increase in process throughput.
