## Comment Notice Issuance of Draft Title V Permit

**Action:** SWCAA is issuing a draft Air Operating Permit (AOP) for Weyerhaeuser Longview Lumber. The draft AOP is a renewal permit, incorporating applicable requirements from Local, State and Federal regulations.

**Facility Description:** Weyerhaeuser Longview Lumber produces dimensional lumber (green and kiln-dried) from raw timber. Lumber operations at the facility include log receiving and storage; lumber receiving and storage, shipping facilities; lumber dry kilns; lumber planer lines, anti-sapstain spray treatment systems, wood residual storage and shipping and maintenance support activities. The facility has the ability to process lumber from offsite sawmills, but does not currently do so.

The facility has six emission units: Lumber Dry Kilns, Planer Mill Material Collection Systems, Planer Mill Spray Systems, Sawmill Dust Collection System, Wood Residual Bins and Emergency Fire Pumps.

**Pollutant Discharge:** Estimated emissions of criteria and hazardous air pollutants to the ambient air for the year 2016 are as follows:

**Project Impact:** This action does not change existing permit limits already established in federally enforceable Air Discharge Permits. All applicable requirements for the Weyerhaeuser Longview Lumber facility have been compiled in draft Air Operating Permit SW18-23-R0. Upon issuance of a final AOP, jurisdiction over this facility will change from the Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) to SWCAA.
