PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the Southwest Clean Air Agency (SWCAA) is providing a forty-five (45) day public comment period to the public of Affected States and EPA for the preliminary determination to issue an Air Discharge Permit (ADP) 20-3413 to Georgia Pacific Consumer Operations LLC. This preliminary determination is to approve installation of a Package Boiler at a facility located at 401 NE Adams Street, Camas, WA 98601.

The extended public comment period is being provided to meet a substantially equivalent permitting process under WAC 173-401-720(1)(c). This comment period applies to ADP 20-3413 only. Once the public comment period has ended and after receiving any comments SWCAA will issue a final ADP as promptly as possible. SWCAA expects a subsequent request by the facility to revise Air Discharge Permit (ADP) SW202410 to incorporate the terms of ADP 20-3413 as an add-on to the amendment consistent with WAC 173-401-720(3)(a). There will be no additional public comment period provided for the SWCAA Air Discharge Permit. This action will increase/decrease emissions at the facility by the following amounts: 4.76 tpy SO₂, 9.64 tpy CO, 2.91 tpy VOC, 625 tpy SO_x, 3.19 tpy PM₁₀ and 603 tpy HAP. Copies of the preliminary Air Discharge Permit and associated Technical Support Document are available for review at the SWCAA, 99th Street, Suite 1000, Vancouver, Washington, Monday through Friday, 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. Electronic copies are available for review on the permit web page of SWCAA's website: www.swcaa.org. Any additional questions and data requests should be directed to SWCAA. This matter will be published in the official newspaper of publication of the county containing significant public information and to meeting that is required by RCW 36A.05.010. The public comment period ends on 05/27/2020.
