



Comment Notice Issuance of Draft Air Discharge Permit

Action: SWCAA is issuing a draft Air Discharge Permit (ADP) for a facility operated by North Pacific Paper Company LLC. The draft ADP is a permit for a new recovered fiber pulp line and incorporates applicable requirements from Local, State and Federal regulations. An extended public comment period is being provided to meet a "substantially equivalent" permitting process under WAC 173-401-720(1)(e). This comment period applies to the issuance of ADP 21-3452 only.

Once the public comment period has ended and comments are resolved, SWCAA will issue a final ADP as promptly as possible. In addition, SWCAA expects a request from the facility to revise Air Operating Permit (AOP) SW20-24-R0 and incorporate the provisions of ADP 21-3452 as an administrative amendment pursuant to WAC 173-401-720. There will be no additional public comment period provided on the administrative amendment to the Air Operating Permit.

Facility Description: NORPAC is located in Longview, Washington. The facility produces newsprint and writing papers. The facility operates thermomechanical pulping (TMP) and de-ink pulping processes. Pulp is made from virgin and secondary fiber materials. Processes at the facility are generally designed to operate continuously.

The facility currently has six emission units: Thermomechanical Pulping Mill, Paper Machine #1, Paper Machine #2, Paper Machine #3, De-inking Pulp Plant and Old Newsprint Baghouse.

Pollutant Discharge: Emissions of criteria pollutants to the ambient air and the expected change in emissions associated with this permitting action are as follows:
