

## Comment Notice Issuance of Draft Title V Permit

**Notice Prepared:** March 1, 2023

**Permit Number:** SW08-15-R2

**Applicant:** Puget Sound Energy – Mint Farm Generating Station

**Action:** SWCAA is issuing a draft AOP for the Mint Farm Generating Station. The draft

AOP is a renewal permit, incorporating applicable requirements from Local, State

and Federal regulations.

Facility Description:

The Mint Farm Generating Station is a natural gas fired combined cycle combustion turbine power facility owned by Puget Sound Energy (PSE). The nominal

generating capacity of the facility is 320 megawatts (MW).

The facility has three emission units: Combustion Turbine/HRSG, Cooling Tower,

and Emergency Generator.

Pollutant Discharge:

Estimated emissions of criteria and hazardous air pollutants to the ambient air for

the year 2021 are as follows:

**Project Impact:** This action does not change existing permit limits already established in federally

enforceable Air Discharge Permits. All applicable requirements for the Mint Farm Generating Station have been compiled in draft Air Operating Permit

SW08-15-R2.
