## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

Notice to the public is hereby given that the Southwest Clean Air Agency (SWCAA) is providing a thirty (30) day public comment period for the preliminary determination to issue Air Discharge Permit 25-3713 to Tristar Transload PNW, Inc. This preliminary determination approves the use of three new butane transloaders at the existing facility located at 3702 NW Gateway Avenue, Vancouver, WA 98660, as well as at the new facility located at 1309 West 11th Street, Vancouver, WA 98660. Tristar is currently permitted for a throughput of 600,000 barrels per year of each product; therefore, this permitting action will not lead to an increase in propane or butane emissions. The new transloader engines will result in an increase of 0.001 tons of SO<sub>2</sub> per year.
