Notice to the public is hereby given that the Southwest Air Pollution Control Authority has made a preliminary Determination to issue a Regulatory Order of Approval, number SWAPCA (90)-(1200), to American Cabinet Concepts for installation of an automated cabinet parts finishing facility at 1021 Columbia Blvd., Longview, WA., to discharge not more than 20 tons/yr. of volatile organic compounds and 300 lbs./yr. of fine particulates to atmosphere.

The public has an opportunity to review and comment on the Determination. All written or oral comments must be received by SWAPCA within 30 days after this Publication. Final action by SWAPCA to approve, modify or deny will be taken within 10 days after the close of the comment period. If there is a demonstrated significant public interest a public hearing may be held with the required 30 day notification.
