### NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF DRAFT EIS AND PUBLIC HEARINGS KING COUNTY SOLID WASTE DIVISION

On February 20, 1991, the King County Solid Waste Division issued the draft environmental impact statement (DEIS) on the selection of one or more private vendors to provide construction, demolition, and land clearing (CDL) waste handling services. The selected vendor disposal facilities would be the only authorized disposal facilities for CDL waste generated within King County's solid waste jurisdiction. Three private vendors are currently under consideration by the County:

Washington Waste Systems, Inc. (WWSI), who proposes to use the existing Columbia Ridge Landfill in Gilliam County, Oregon. The WWSI proposal includes two recycling/transfer stations, one in Seattle at either 80 South Hudson Street or 7901 First Avenue South, and one in suburban King County at a site which has not yet been named. Non-recycled CDL waste would be transported by rail to the landfill. King County's CDL waste would be commingled with, and transported and disposed together with, mixed municipal solid waste (MMSW) handled under WWSI's contract with the City of Seattle. Under the Seattle contract, WWSI is required to site and permit a landfill in eastern Washington, and is currently evaluating sites in Adams County. If an eastern Washington landfill is permitted, and Seattle decides to dispose of its MMSW at that facility, King County's CDL waste would also be disposed there. An eastern Washington landfill is not evaluated in this DEIS, because it is speculative at this time. King County would conduct additional environmental review before directing CDL waste to an eastern Washington site.

Rabanco Regional Landfill Company (RRLC), who proposes to use the existing Roosevelt Regional Landfill in Klickitat County, Washington, or a proposed CDL/Woodwaste Landfill on the same site. The RRLC proposal includes two recycling/transfer stations, an existing one in Seattle at 2733 Third Avenue South, and a proposed facility in Renton on 68th Avenue South. Non-recycled CDL waste would be transported by the rail to the landfill.

Pacific Coast Coal Company/John Henry Reclamation, Inc. (PCCC/JHR), who proposes to develop a landfill in mine pits on the site of the John Henry coal mine in Black Diamond, Washington. No recycling/transfer stations are included in the PCCC/JHR proposal, but recovery of recyclable materials from CDL waste would take place at the landfill site.
