Notice to the public is hereby given that the Southwest Air Pollution Control Authority (SWAPCA) has made a preliminary determination to issue Regulatory Order of Approval Number 95-1833 to U.S. Natural Resources, for approval of a spray coating and welding operations located at 558 Robinson Road, in Woodland, Washington. In accordance with the State Environmental Policy Act, a Determination of Nonsignificance has been made regarding this project. Emissions from the operations are not to exceed the following: 11.0 tons per year of VOC and 3.0 tons per year of particulate matter combined, from combustion of propane. Emissions of toxic air pollutants are not to exceed the acceptable source impact level or the small quantity emission rate in WAC 173-460. Emissions of xylene are not to exceed 6.0 tons per year.

The public has an opportunity to review and comment on the preliminary Order of Approval. This preliminary Order of Approval will be made available in other media, if necessary. All written or oral comments must be received by SWAPCA within 30 days after this publication. Final action by SWAPCA to approve, modify, or deny the proposal will be taken within 10 days after the close of the comment period. If there is a demonstrated significant public interest, a public hearing may be held with the required 30 day notification.
