This preliminary determination includes increasing the facility-wide hazardous air pollutants limit from 8.0 tpy to 9.0 tpy, increasing chlorine emission limit, minor modifications to permit conditions, including changes to monitoring and testing requirements, and removal of previously approved equipment.
