## **DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 22-004**

#### **Description of proposal:**

ADP Application CL-3506: The proponent has applied for a permit to install and operate new spray coating equipment with particulate matter filters as well as operate existing natural gas-fired equipment. The new equipment will produce emissions of nitrogen oxides, carbon monoxide, sulfur dioxide, volatile organic compounds and toxic air pollutants. At the emission levels proposed, this equipment will not have a significant adverse impact on ambient air quality. This permitting action is not expected to have any effect on traffic, noise, glare, housing, or recreation opportunities.
