DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 22-024

Description of proposal:

ADP Application CL-3206: The proponent has applied for a permit to operate new rock crushing equipment in an existing quarry. The new equipment will produce emissions of particulate matter from crushing and nitrogen oxides, carbon monoxide, volatile organic compounds, and sulfur dioxide from the use of a diesel engine. At the emission levels proposed, this equipment will not have a significant adverse impact on ambient air quality. This permitting action is not expected to have any effect on traffic, noise, glare, housing, or recreation opportunities.
