

State Environmental Policy Act DETERMINATION OF SEPA EXEMPT - SWCAA 23-001

Description of proposal:

ADP Application CL-3219: The proponent has applied for a permit to remove Stage II vapor recovery equipment at an existing gas station. Stage II vapor recovery equipment collects displaced vapors from vehicle gas tanks during refueling and returns the vapors to the gas station storage tank. Stage II vapor recovery is becoming increasingly redundant with the increased fleet penetration of on-board carbon canisters in individual vehicles. This permitting action is expected to result in reduced gasoline vapor emissions because the existing Stage II vapor recovery system is not compatible with the onboard refueling vapor recovery systems on newer vehicles. This permitting action is not expected to have any impact on any other element of the environment including traffic, noise, glare, housing, or recreation opportunities.

Neither an environmental checklist nor an environmental impact statement (EIS) is required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made by the lead agency after review of the proponent's proposal and the information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.
