ADP Application CL-3185: The proponent has applied for a permit to install a new reactor and associated ammonia scrubber at a semiconductor research and development facility. Small amounts of toxic air pollutants, primarily ammonia, may be emitted from this unit. At the emission levels proposed, the new equipment will not have a significant adverse impact on ambient air quality. This permitting action is not expected to have a significant adverse impact on any element of the environment, including traffic, noise, glare, housing, or recreation opportunities.
