DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 23-005

Description of proposal:

ADP Application CL-3064: The proponent has applied for a permit to approve the operation of various portable diesel engine driver rock crushing equipment in SWCAA's jurisdiction. The equipment is portable, and the permit allows for operation at sites within Clark, Cowlitz, Lewis, Skamania, and Wahkiakum Counties in southwest Washington. At the potential emission levels, the proposed equipment will not cause a violation of any ambient air quality standard. This permitting action is not expected to have any effect on traffic, noise, glare, housing, or recreation opportunities.
