DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 23-013

Description of proposal:

ADP Application CO-1063: Applicant proposes to operate new rock crushing equipment for the primary purpose of recycling aggregate materials. The proposed project will be located on a vacant parcel of industrial land, and is not expected to significantly change the nature or level of impact of existing neighborhood activities on general elements of the environment (e.g., traffic, noise, glare, housing, recreation opportunities, etc.). Proposed equipment will produce air emissions of particulate matter from crushing operations and nitrogen oxides, carbon monoxide, volatile organic compounds, and sulfur dioxide from operation of diesel engine power units. At the proposed level of operation, the project is not expected to have a significant adverse impact on ambient air quality.
