## **DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 23-018**

## **Description of proposal:**

ADP Application CL-3227: Installation of new boiler. A single natural gas fired package boiler will be installed to expand capacity at an existing manufacturing facility. No changes are proposed to existing operations. Impact on air will be minimized through the use of low sulfur fuel and low emission burner technology. Impact on other media (traffic, light, noise, water, soil, etc.) is expected to be negligible.
