DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 23-039

Description of proposal:

ADP Application CO-1079: Installation of a new solvent recycling system. The proposed recycling system is a package unit that will be used to recover solvent from paint waste generated onsite at the facility. Installation will not require excavation or building construction. Existing operations at the facility will not be affected by this project. Impact on air will be minimized through the use of process enclosure and vapor condensation. Impact on other media (traffic, light, noise, water, etc.) is expected to be negligible.
