DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 24-001

Description of proposal:

ADP Application L-738: Operation of a portable rock crushing operation consisting of one aggregate crusher, one aggregate screen, and associated material transfer equipment. The proposed equipment will primarily process recycled asphalt from offsite projects. The proposed equipment is portable and will operate at multiple locations. Operation of the crushing equipment will not involve the construction of any structures or roads. Impact on air will be minimized through the use of wet suppression. Impact on other media (traffic, light, noise, water, etc.) is expected to be minimal and consistent with existing land use.
