

## State Environmental Policy Act DETERMINATION OF SEPA EXEMPT - SWCAA 24-007

## Description of proposal:

ADP Application L-741: The proponent has applied for a permit to increase gasoline throughput at an existing gas station. Increasing gasoline throughput will increase emissions of volatile organic compounds (gasoline vapors), including toxic air pollutants. No change in gasoline vapor recovery equipment is proposed. The only other possible impact of this proposal is increased vehicular traffic. The original SEPA review did not quantify, or result in a limit on, vehicle traffic at this site.

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that the proposed project is exempt from SEPA under WAC 197-11-800(3) as follows: "The repair, remodeling, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing private or public structures, facilities or equipment, including utilities, recreation, and transportation facilities involving no material expansions or changes in use beyond that previously existing; ...." There is no physical change proposed in the project and emissions to the ambient air will remain lower than they would have been when previous SEPA reviews were conducted. Neither an environmental checklist nor an environmental impact statement (EIS) is required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made by the lead agency after review of the proponent's proposal and the information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.

This project/permitting action by SWCAA is SEPA exempt.
