DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) 24-005**

**Description of proposal:**

Vancouver Ford Inc. submitted Air Discharge Permit (ADP) Application CL-3247 to the Southwest Clean Air Agency in which the facility is seeking approval to operate an existing Spray Liner Booth. The new equipment will produce emissions of volatile organic compounds and toxic air pollutants. At the emission levels proposed, this equipment will not have a significant adverse impact on ambient air quality. This permitting action is not expected to have any effect on traffic, noise, glare, housing, or recreation opportunities.
