DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 24-010

Description of proposal:

NEP Application CO-1092: Operation of a diesel engine driven generator. The proposed generator is portable and will operate at various locations in SWCAA's jurisdiction. The generator will operate in support of portable aggregate crushing equipment and portable hot-mix asphalt plants owned by the proponent. Impact on air will be minimized through the use of low sulfur fuel and engine based emission controls. Impact on other media (traffic, light, noise, water, etc.) is expected to be minimal and of a temporary nature.
