DETERMINATION OF SEPA EXEMPTION 24-046**

Description of proposal:

Evergreen School District submitted Air Discharge Permit (ADP) application CL-3276 to the Southwest Clean Air Agency in which the facility is seeking approval to install two 3.0 MMBtu/hr ATH model KN-30+ boilers.

The ADP application was required as part of an enforcement action since two new boilers had been installed without approval.

Evergreen School District is a public primary education provider for Vancouver, WA.

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that the proposed project is exempt from the requirements of the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) under Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 197-11-800(3) as follows: "The repair, remodeling, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing private or public structures, facilities or equipment, including utilities, recreation, and transportation facilities involving no material expansions or changes in use beyond that previously existing." The proposed project is identified as maintenance of existing equipment and as such it does not have a probable significant impact on the environment. Neither an environmental checklist nor an Environmental Impact Statement is required under Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made by SWCAA after review of the proponent's proposal and the information on file with the lead agency, which is available upon request.

This project/permitting action by SWCAA is SEPA exempt.
