

State Environmental Policy Act DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE 25-029

Description of proposal:

Tristar Transload PNW, Inc. submitted Air Discharge Permit (ADP) application CL-3288 to the Southwest Clean Air Agency in which the facility is seeking approval to operate three new butane transloading units and approval to operate at an additional site. Tristar Transload transfers liquified petroleum gas from railcars to tanker trucks using portable transloaders. Tristar is currently permitted for both the throughput of butane and propane at their facility. At the emission levels proposed, this equipment will not have a significant adverse impact on ambient air quality. This permitting action is not expected to have any effect on traffic, noise, glare, housing, or recreation opportunities.
