

State Environmental Policy Act DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE 25-031

Description of proposal:

Knife River Corporation – Kalama Quarry submitted Air Discharge Permit (ADP) application CO-1117 to the Southwest Clean Air Agency in which the facility is seeking approval to install and operate a portable rock crushing plant. The plant consists of one jaw crusher and one scalper screen each powered by a nonroad diesel engine. At the emission levels proposed, this equipment will not have a significant adverse impact on ambient air quality. This permitting action is not expected to have any effect on traffic, noise, glare, housing, or recreation opportunities.
