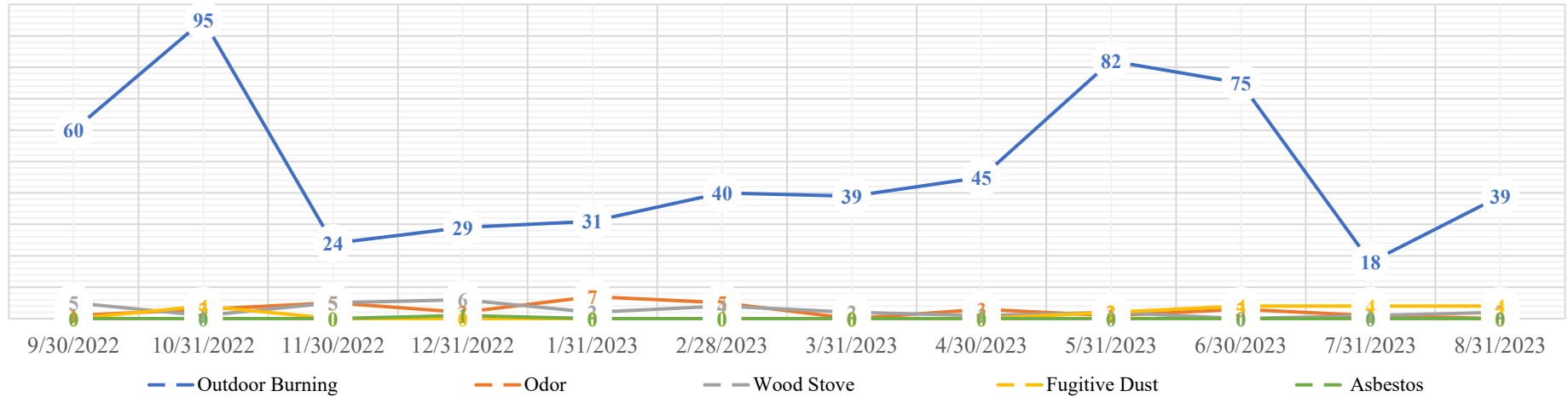
#### NON-TITLE V New Source Review - Permitting Actions

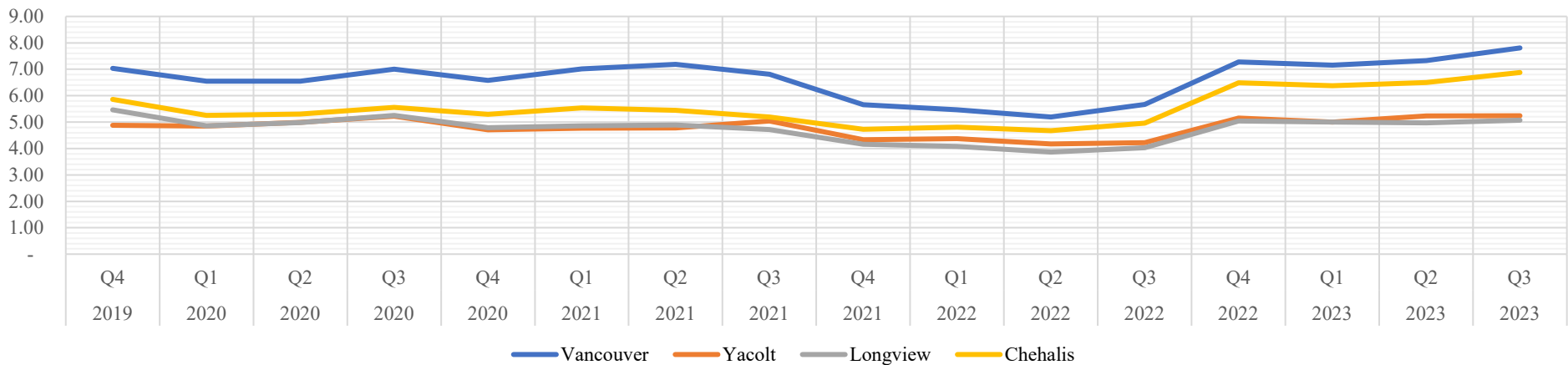


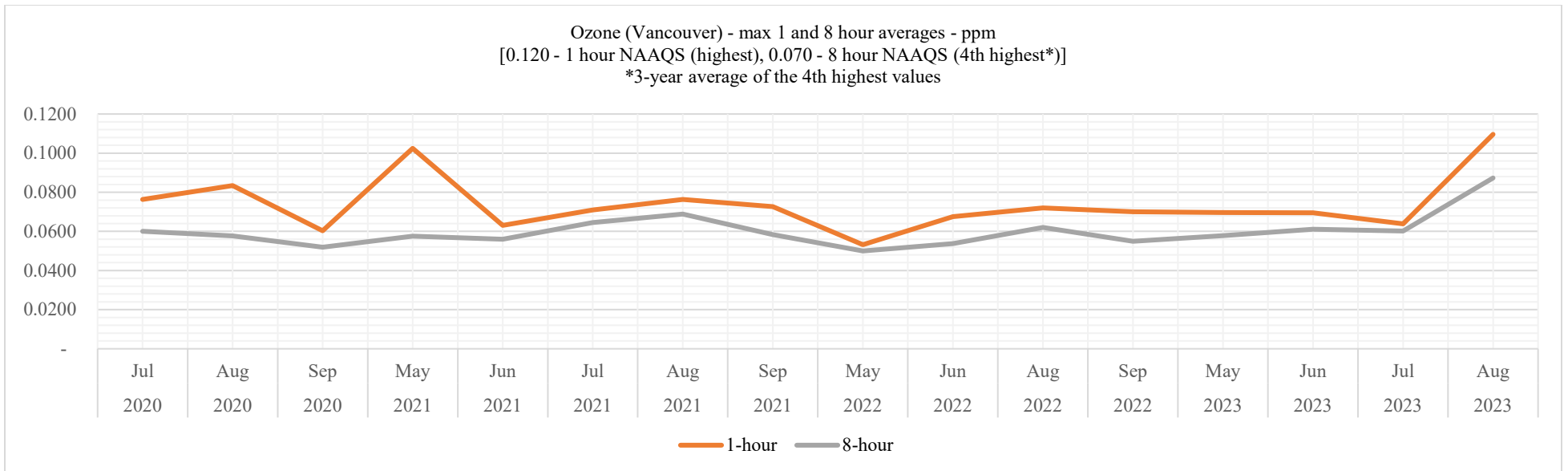
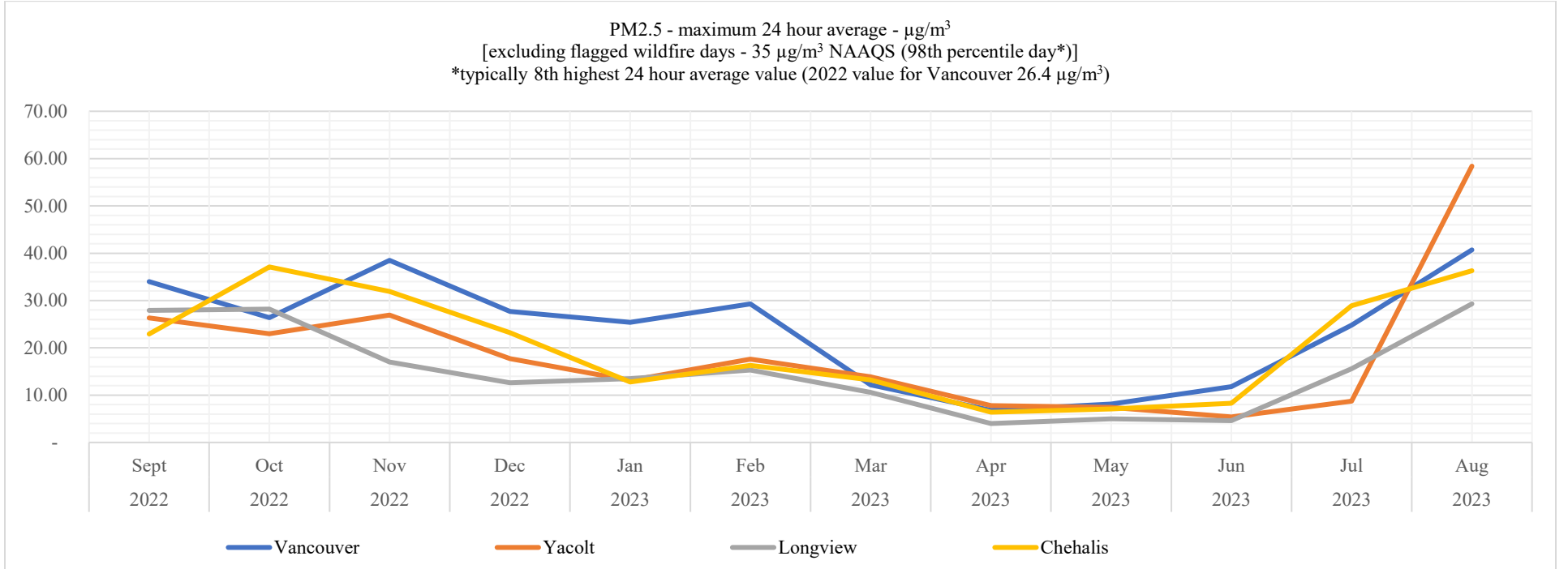

### AMBIENT AIR MONITORING DATA

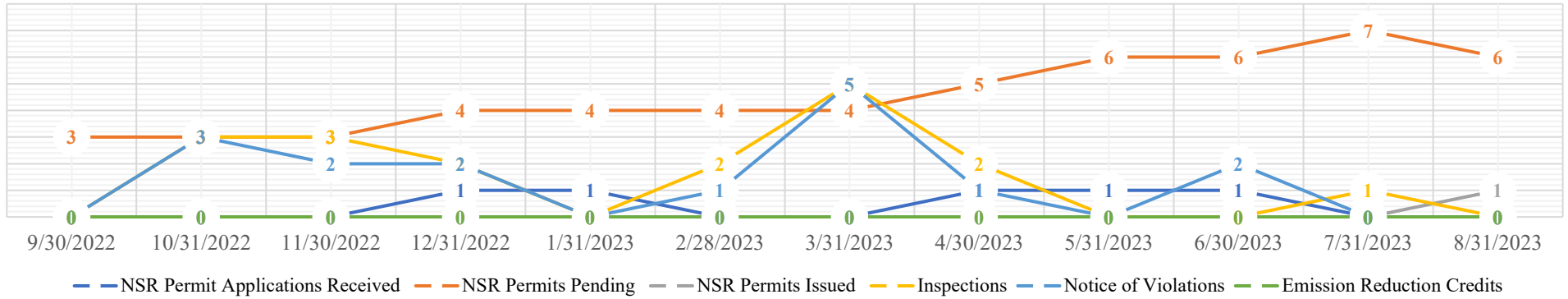
PM2.5 - rolling annual averages -  $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$  (excluding flagged wildfire day)

\*EPA proposed to lower NAAQS to between 8 and 10  $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$





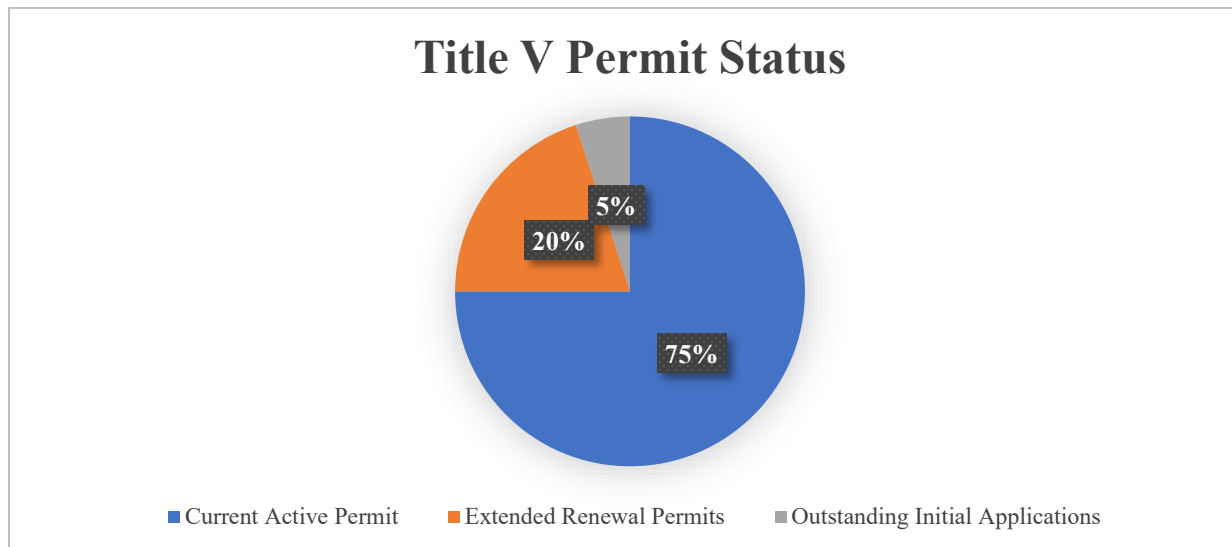

Major Industrial Sources**



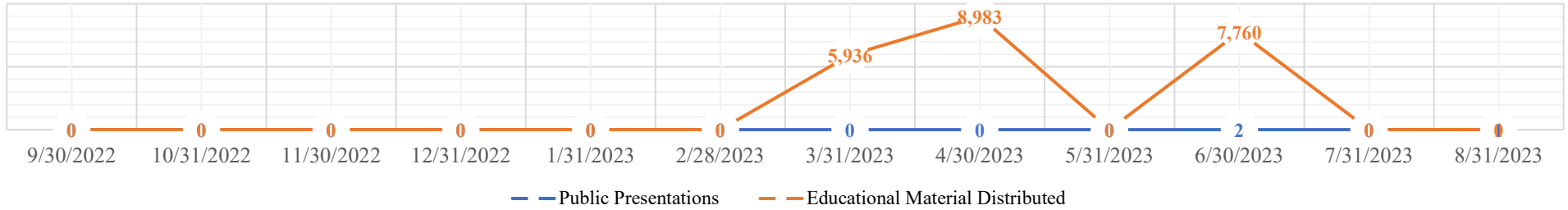
