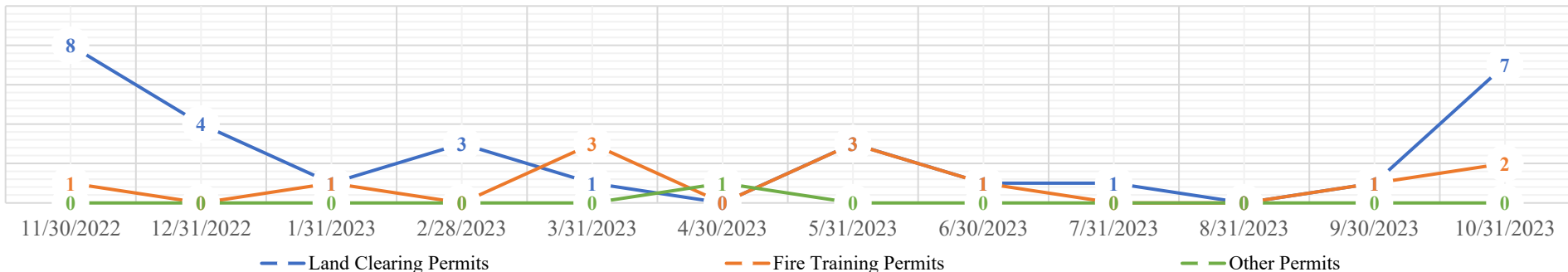

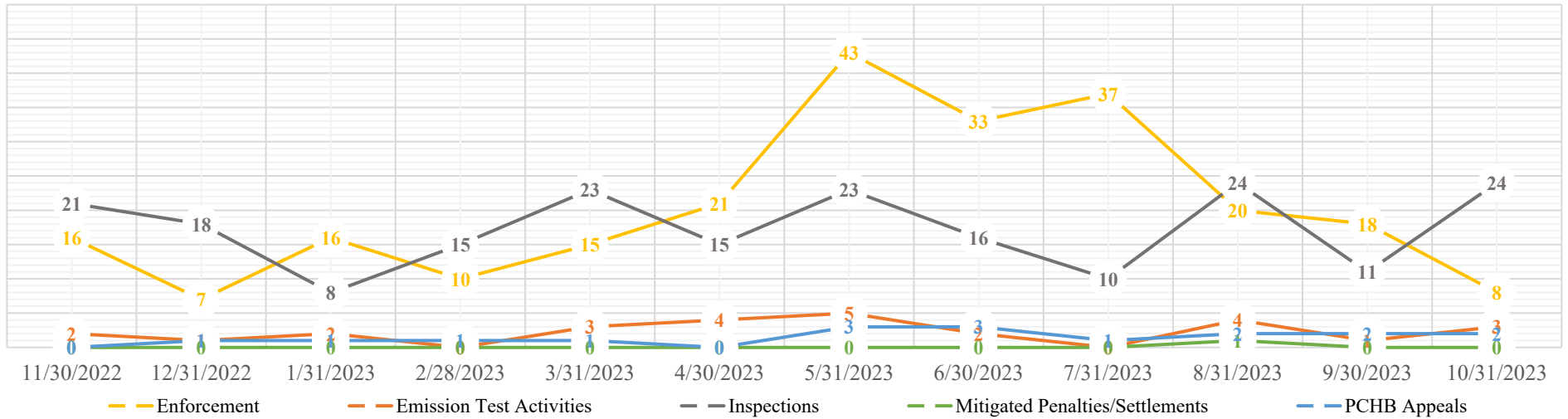

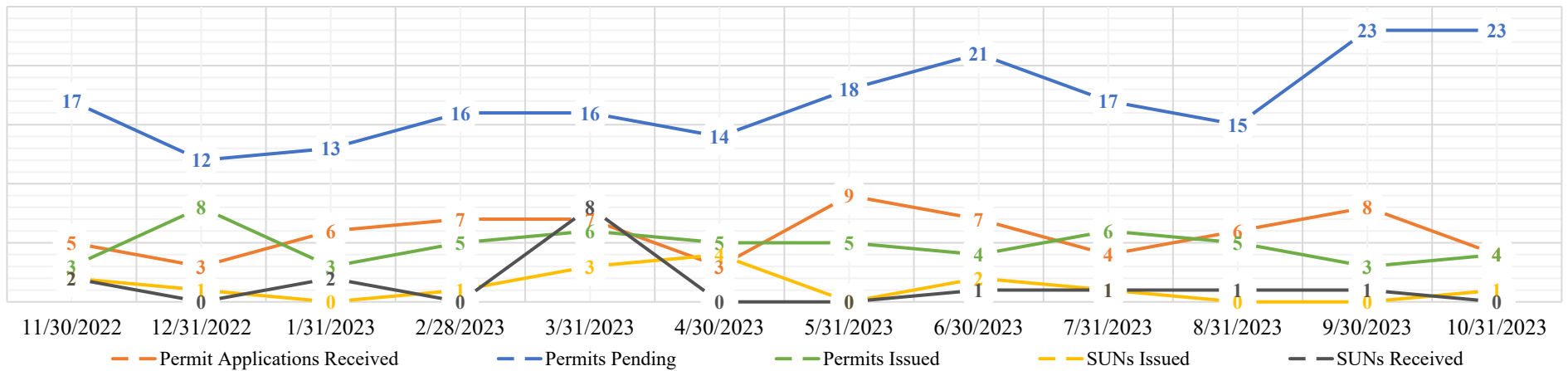

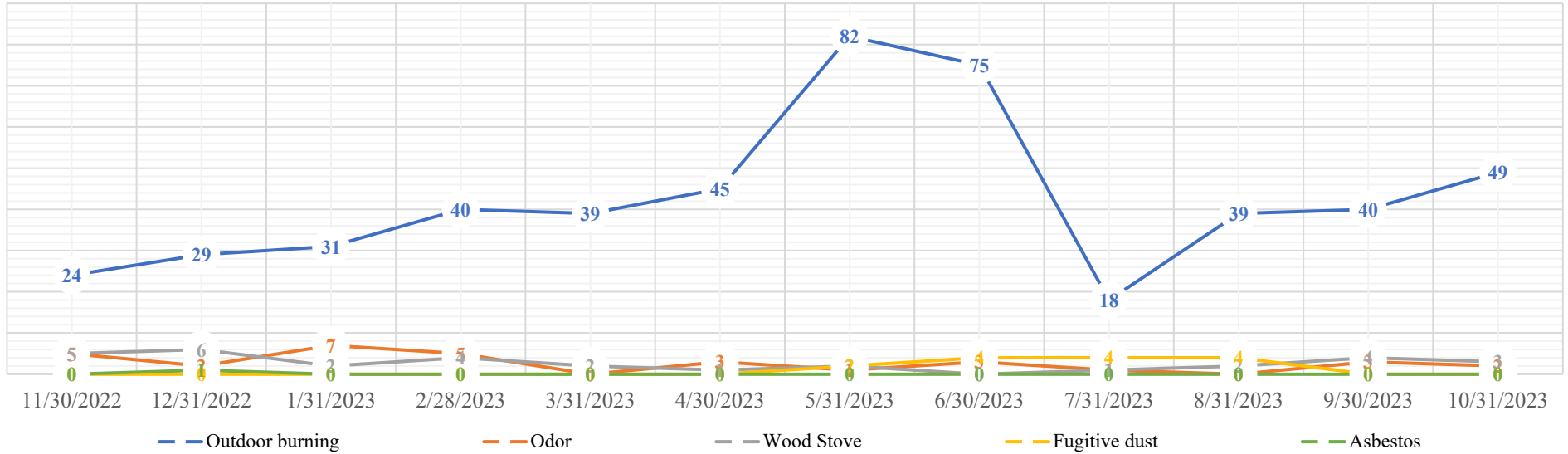


NON-TITLE V New Source Review - Permitting Actions



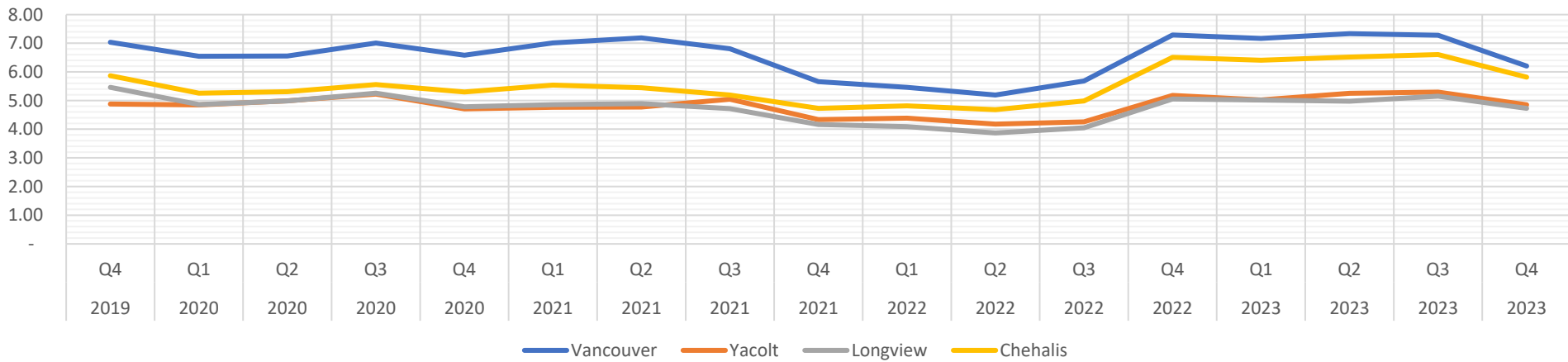

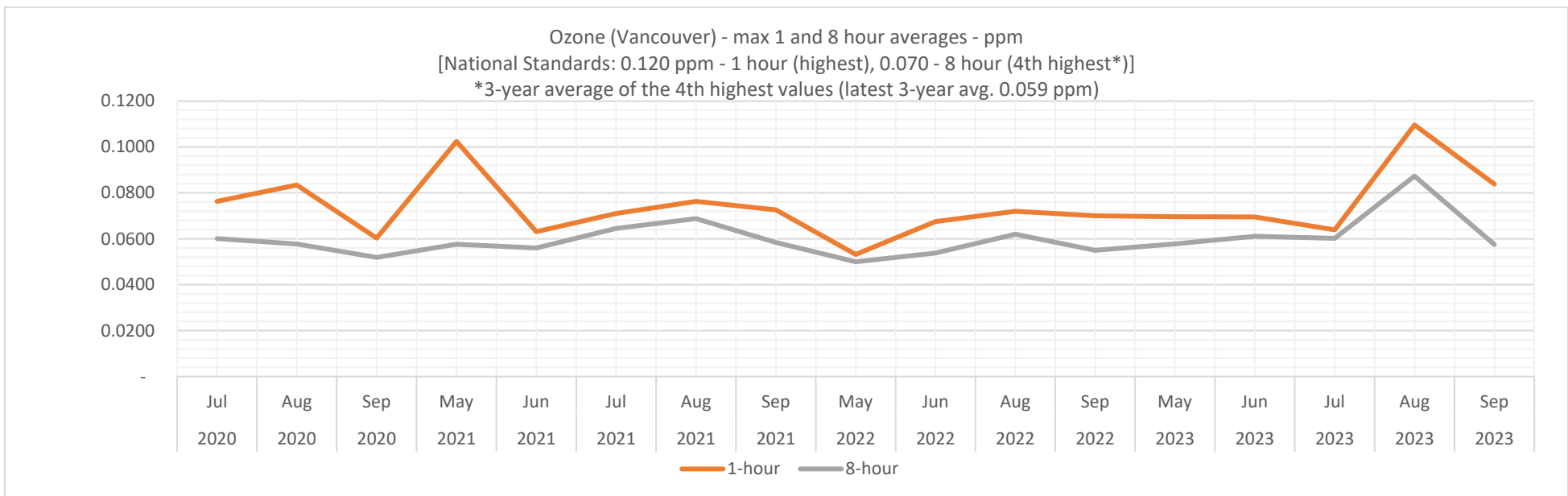
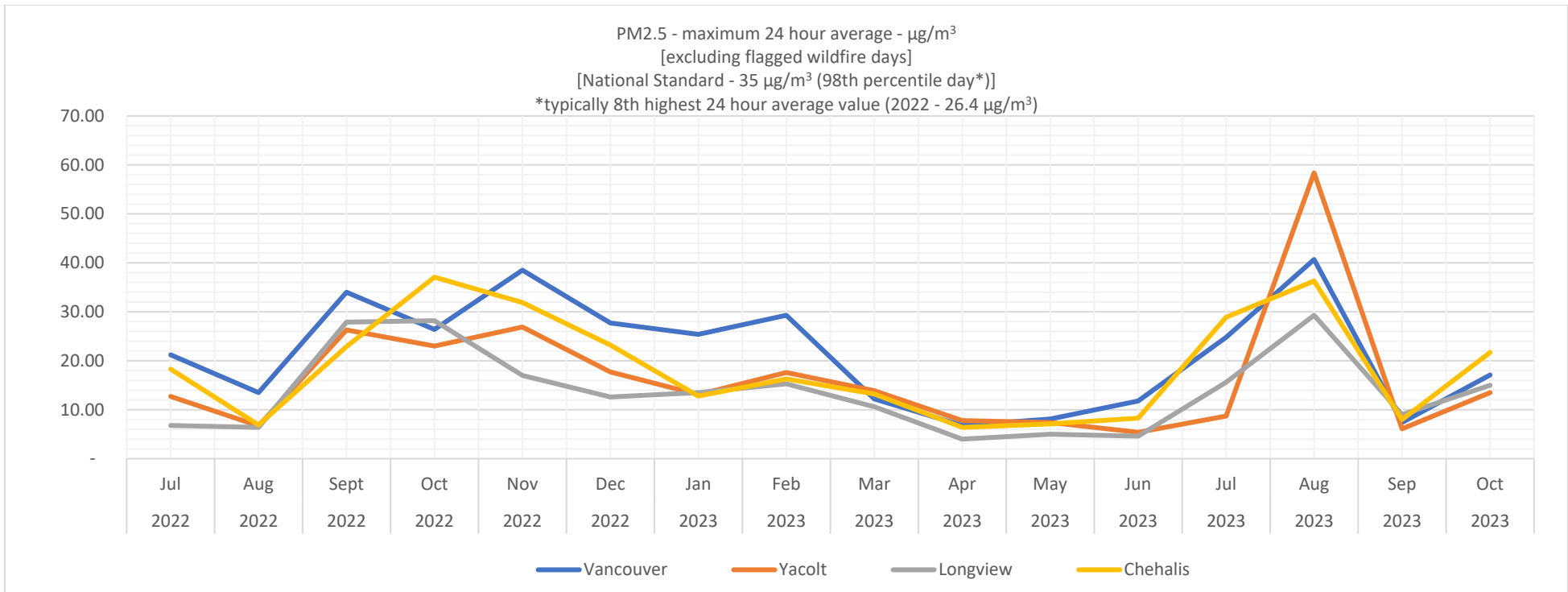

AMBIENT AIR MONITORING DATA

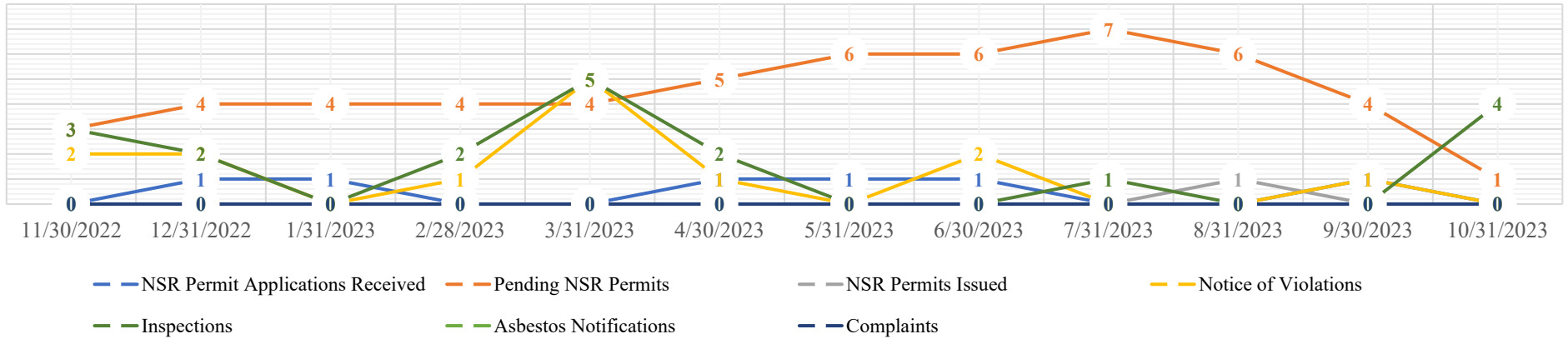
PM2.5 - rolling annual averages - μm^3 (excluding flagged wildfire day)

 *EPA proposed to lower NAAQS to between 8 and $10 \mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$





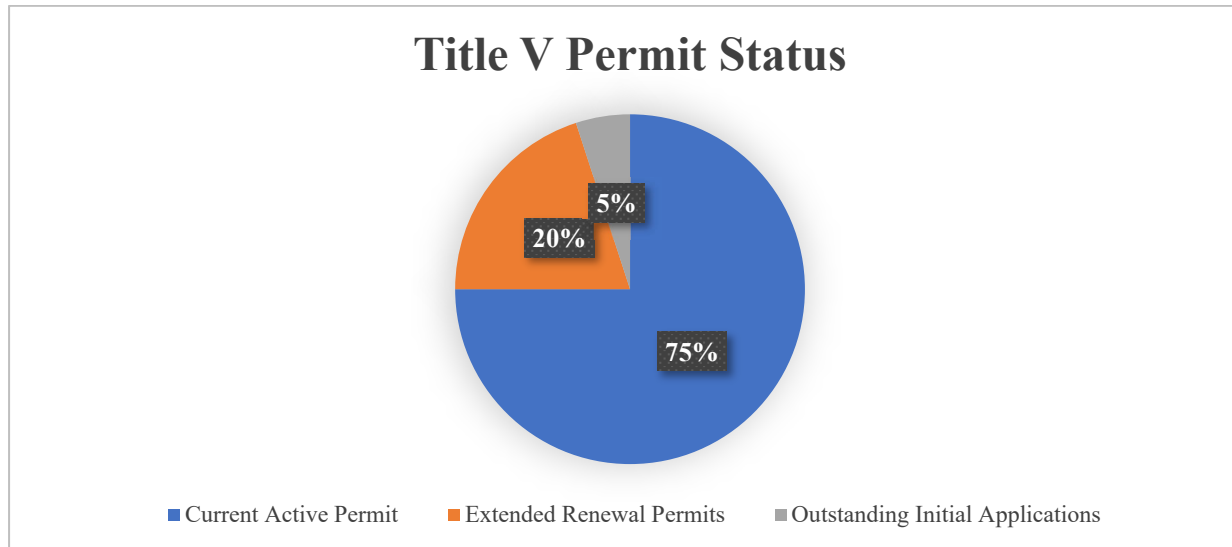

TITLE V Major Industrial Sources



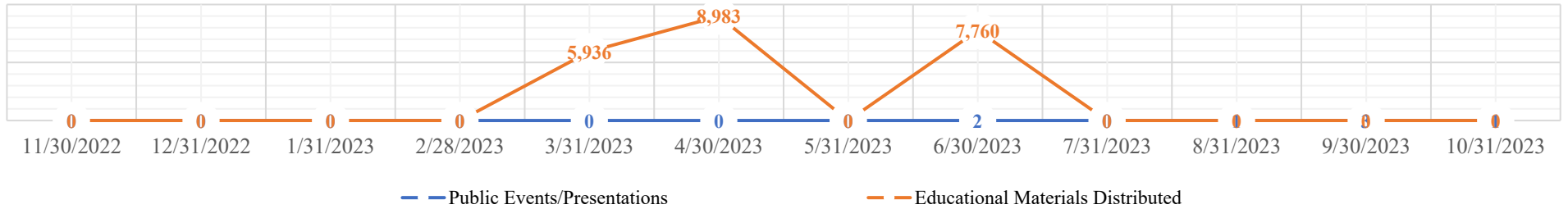

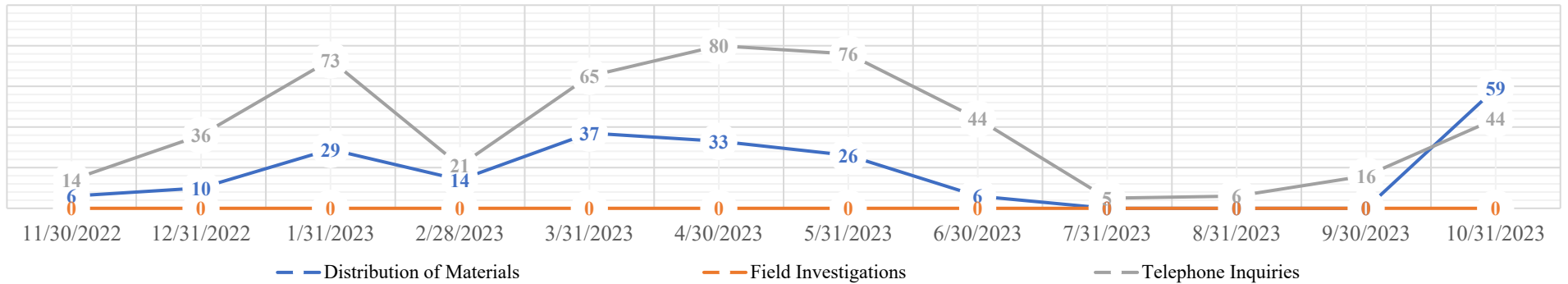

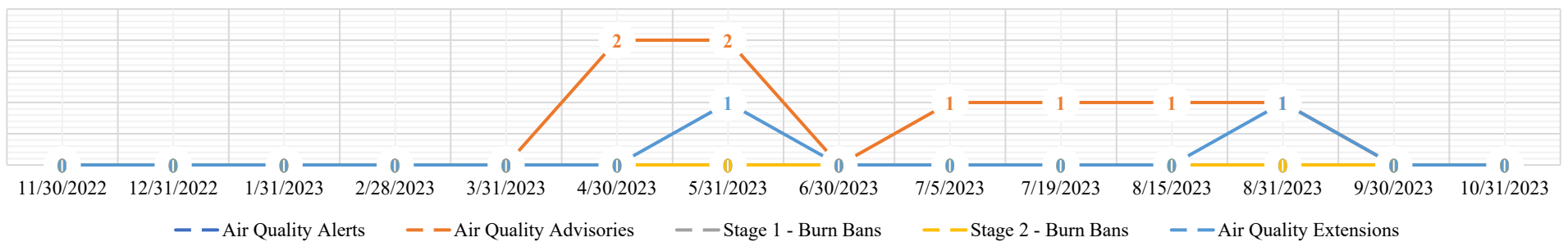

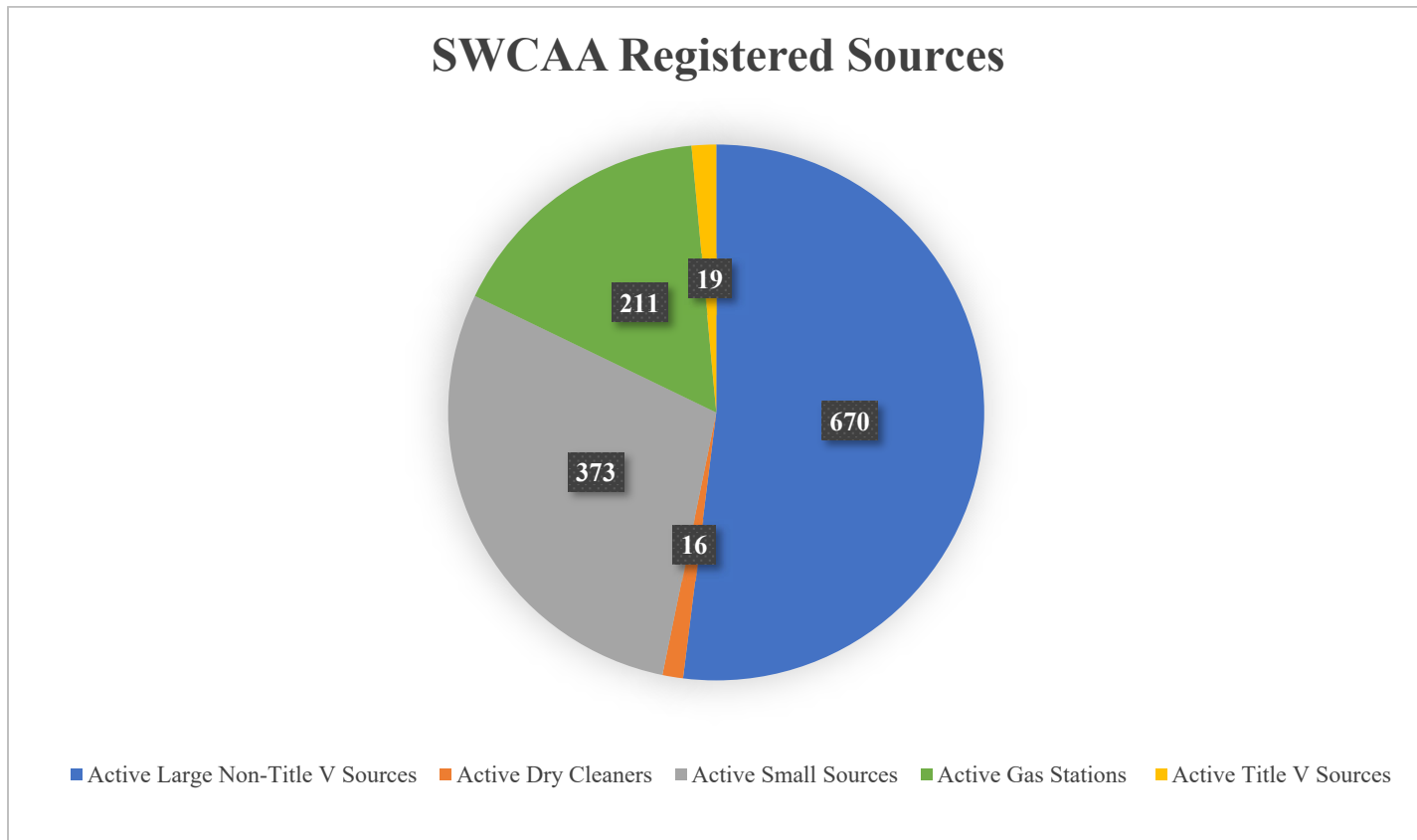


1. Significant Events During the Month:
