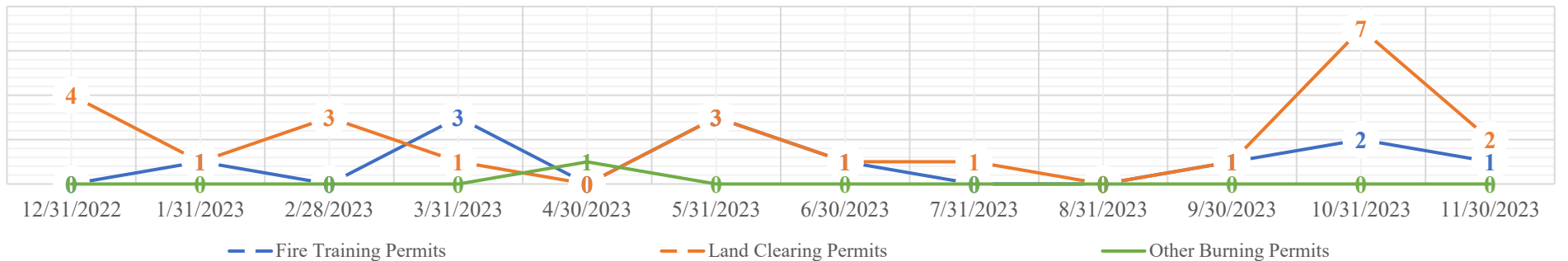

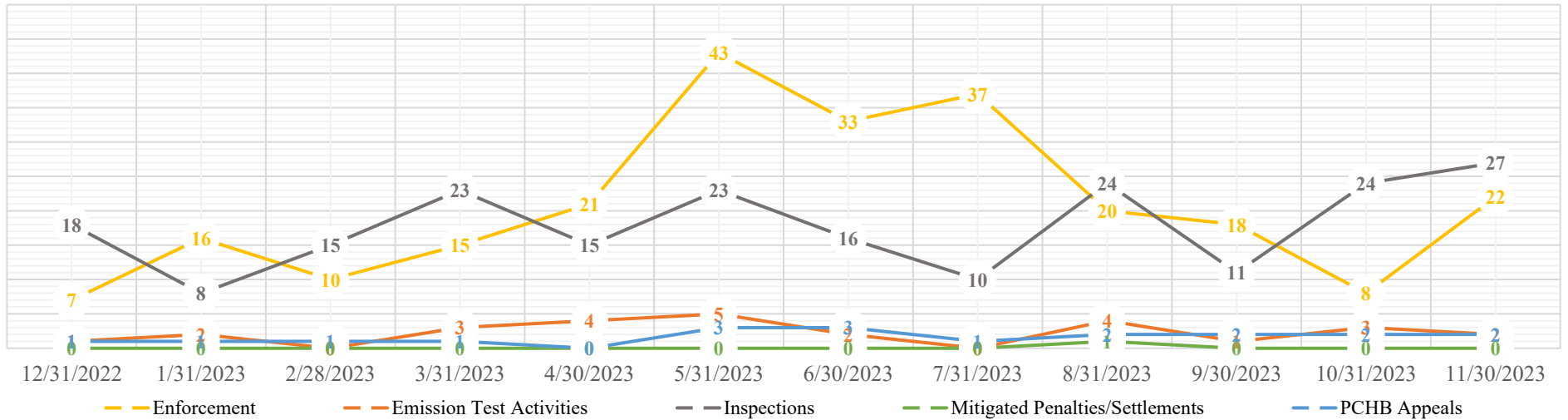

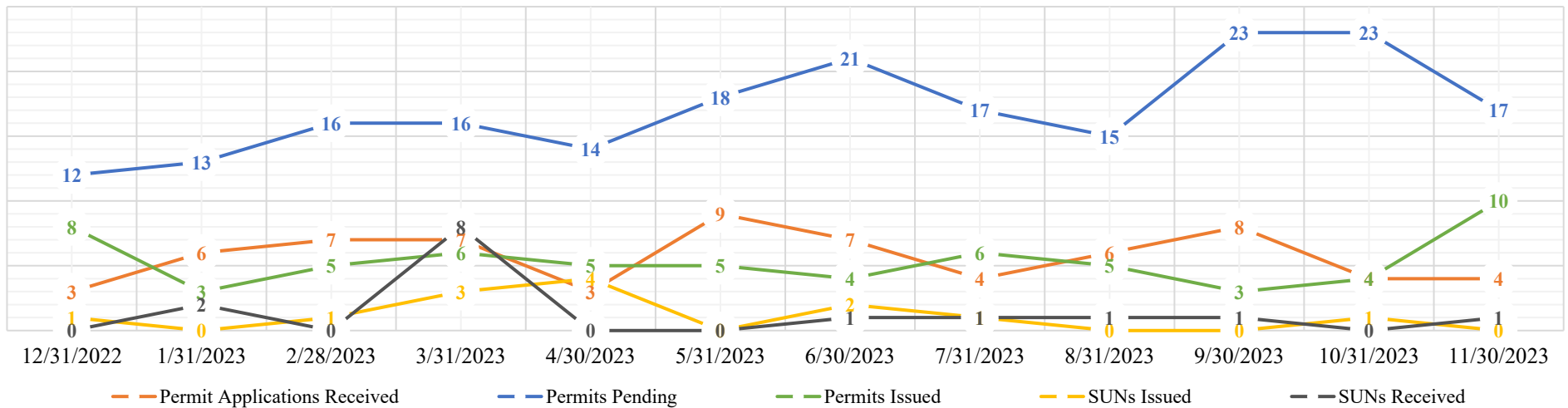

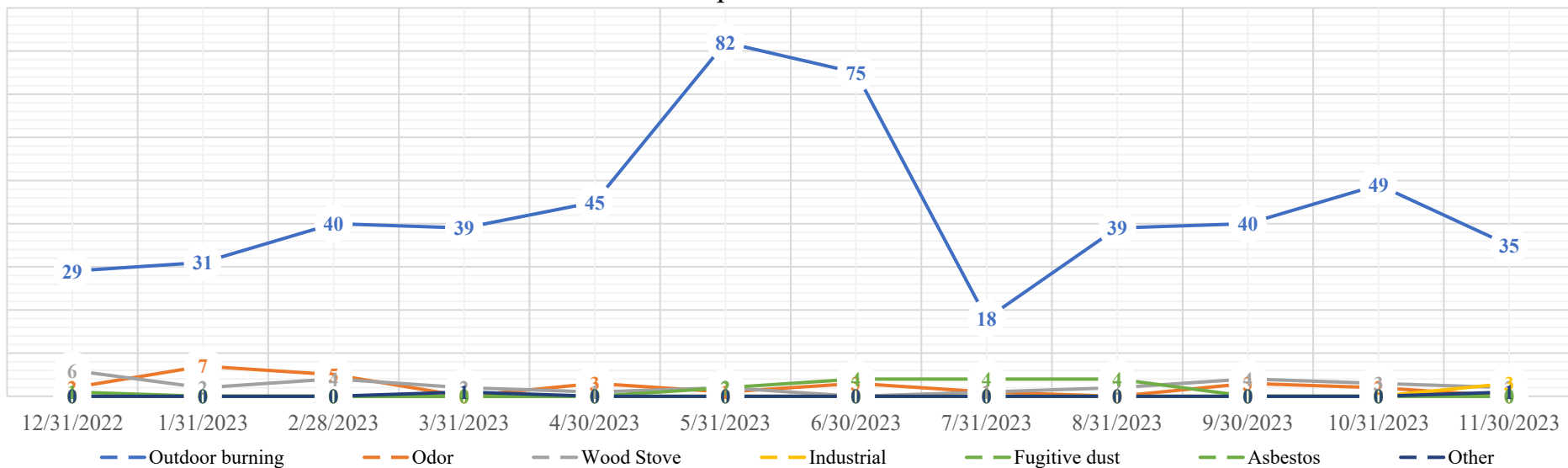


NON-TITLE V New Source Review - Permitting Actions



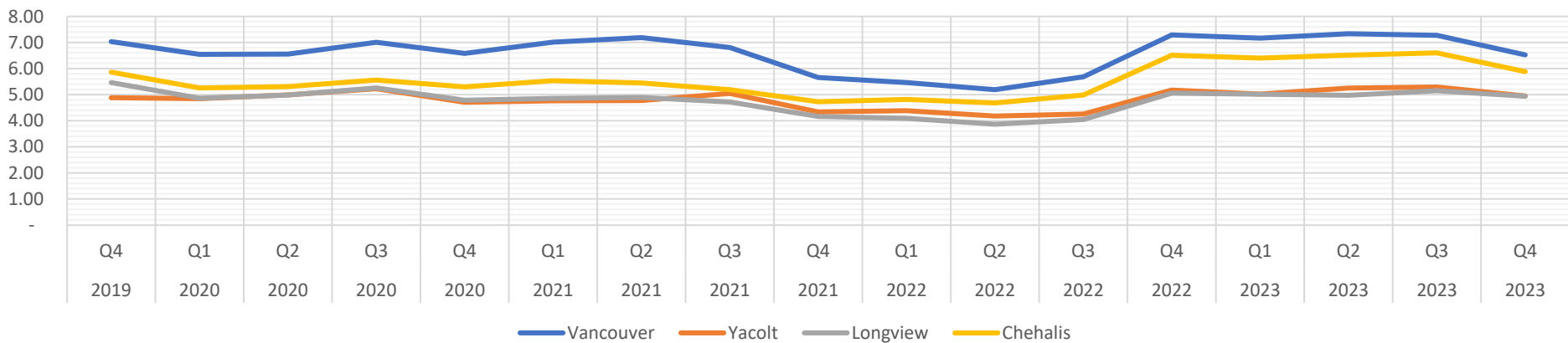

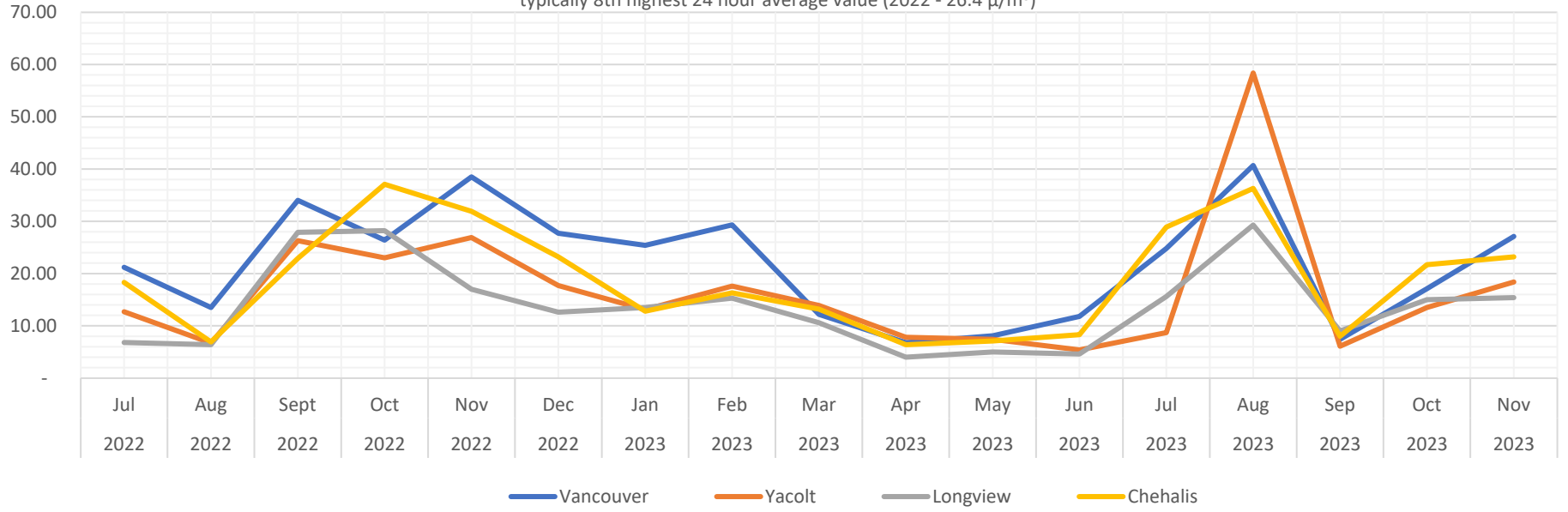


AMBIENT AIR MONITORING DATA

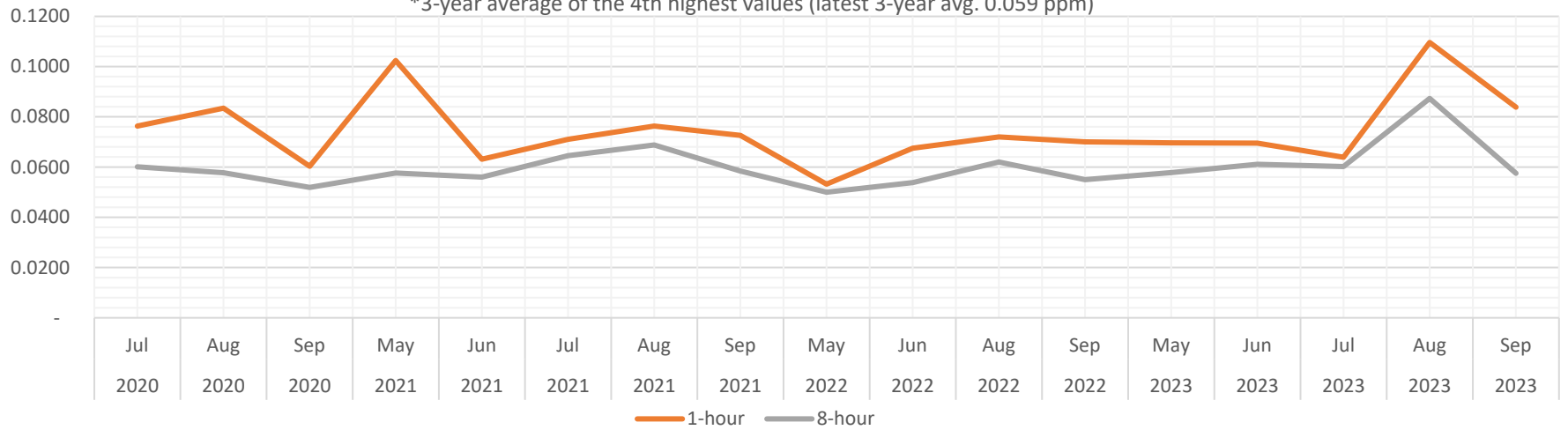
PM2.5 - rolling annual averages - μm^3 (excluding flagged wildfire day)
 [National Standard - $12 \mu\text{m}^3$ * (annual average)]
 *EPA proposed to lower NAAQS to between 8 and $10 \mu\text{m}^3$



PM2.5 - maximum 24 hour average - $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$
 [excluding flagged wildfire days]
 [National Standard - $35 \mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$ (98th percentile day*)]
 *typically 8th highest 24 hour average value (2022 - $26.4 \mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$)

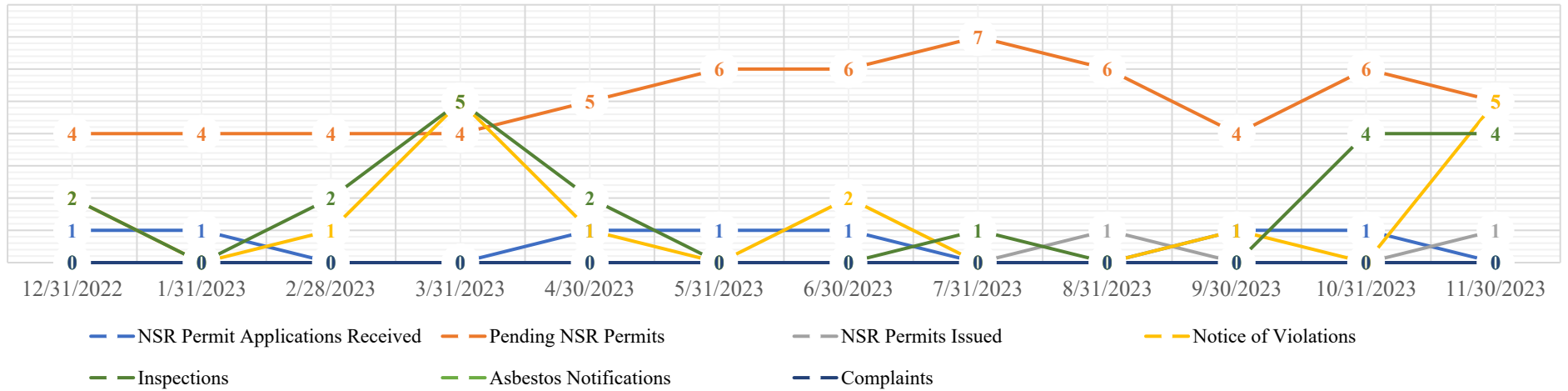


Ozone (Vancouver) - max 1 and 8 hour averages - ppm
 [National Standards: 0.120 ppm - 1 hour (highest), 0.070 - 8 hour (4th highest*)]
 *3-year average of the 4th highest values (latest 3-year avg. 0.059 ppm)



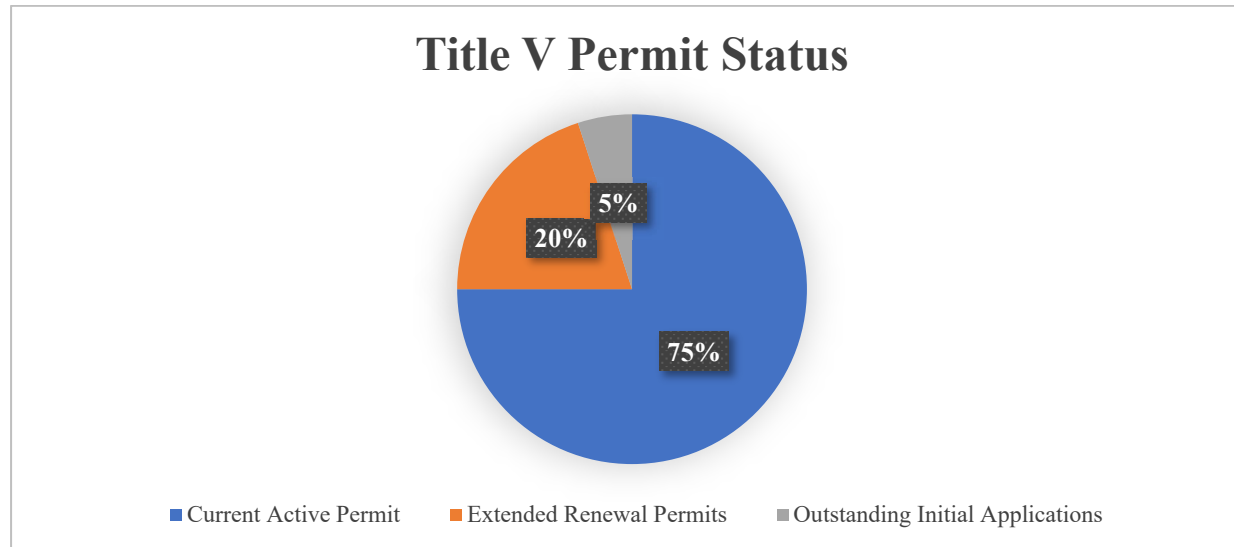

TITLE V Major Industrial Sources

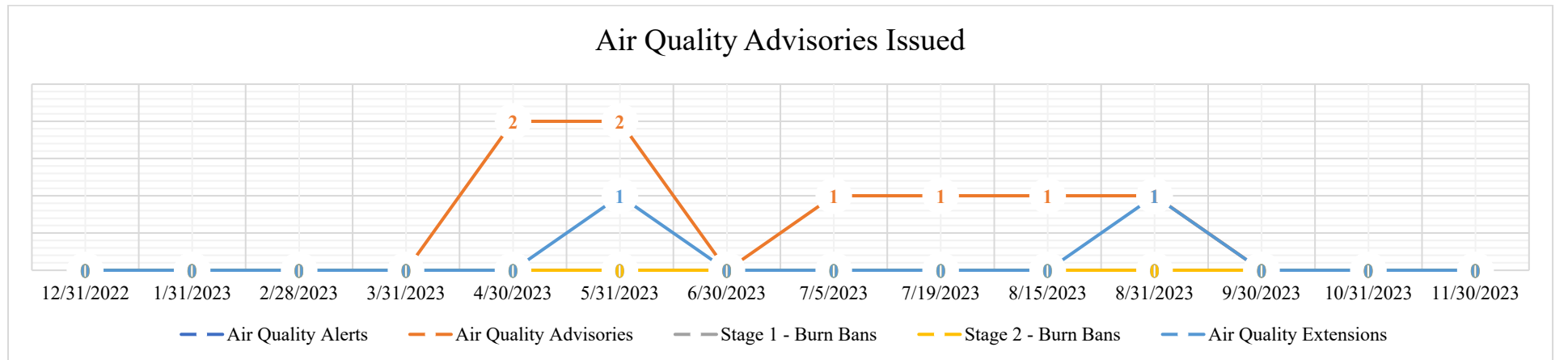
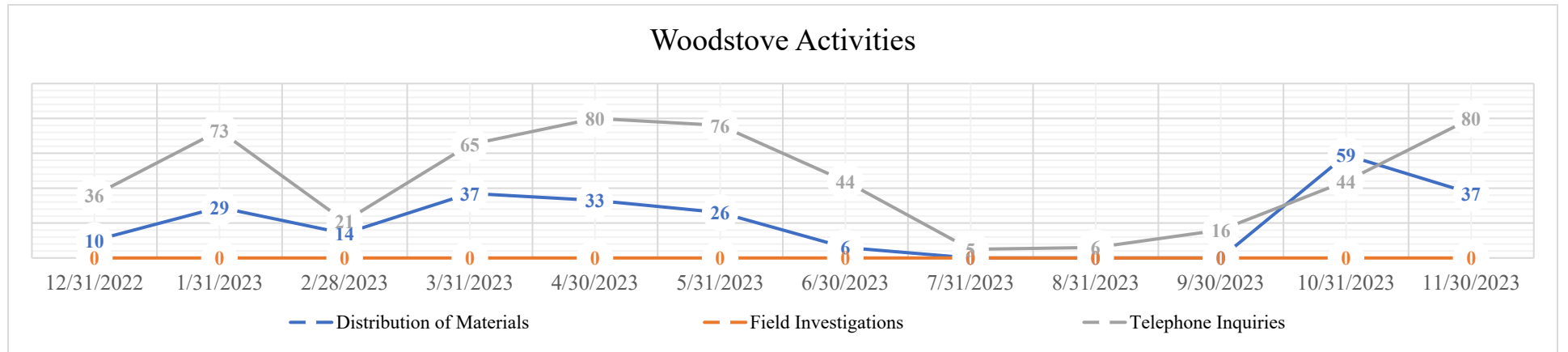
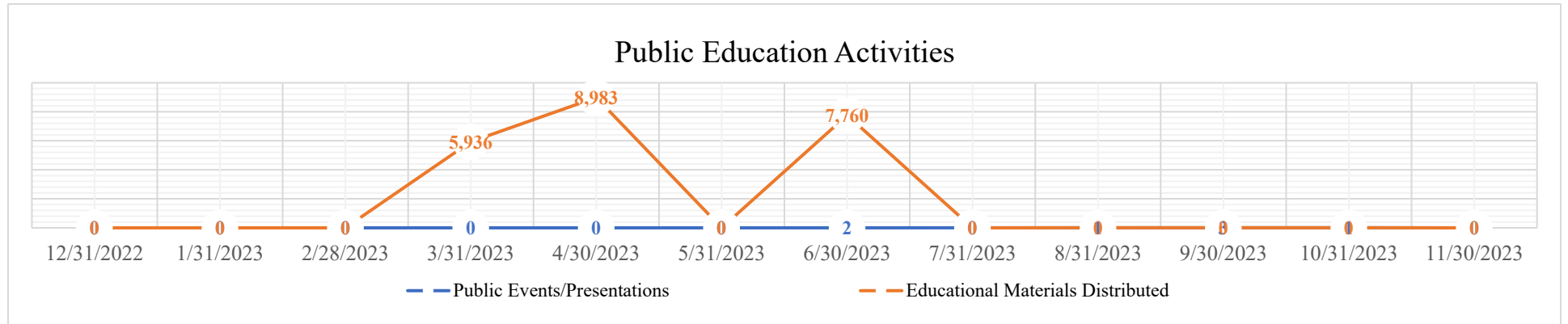

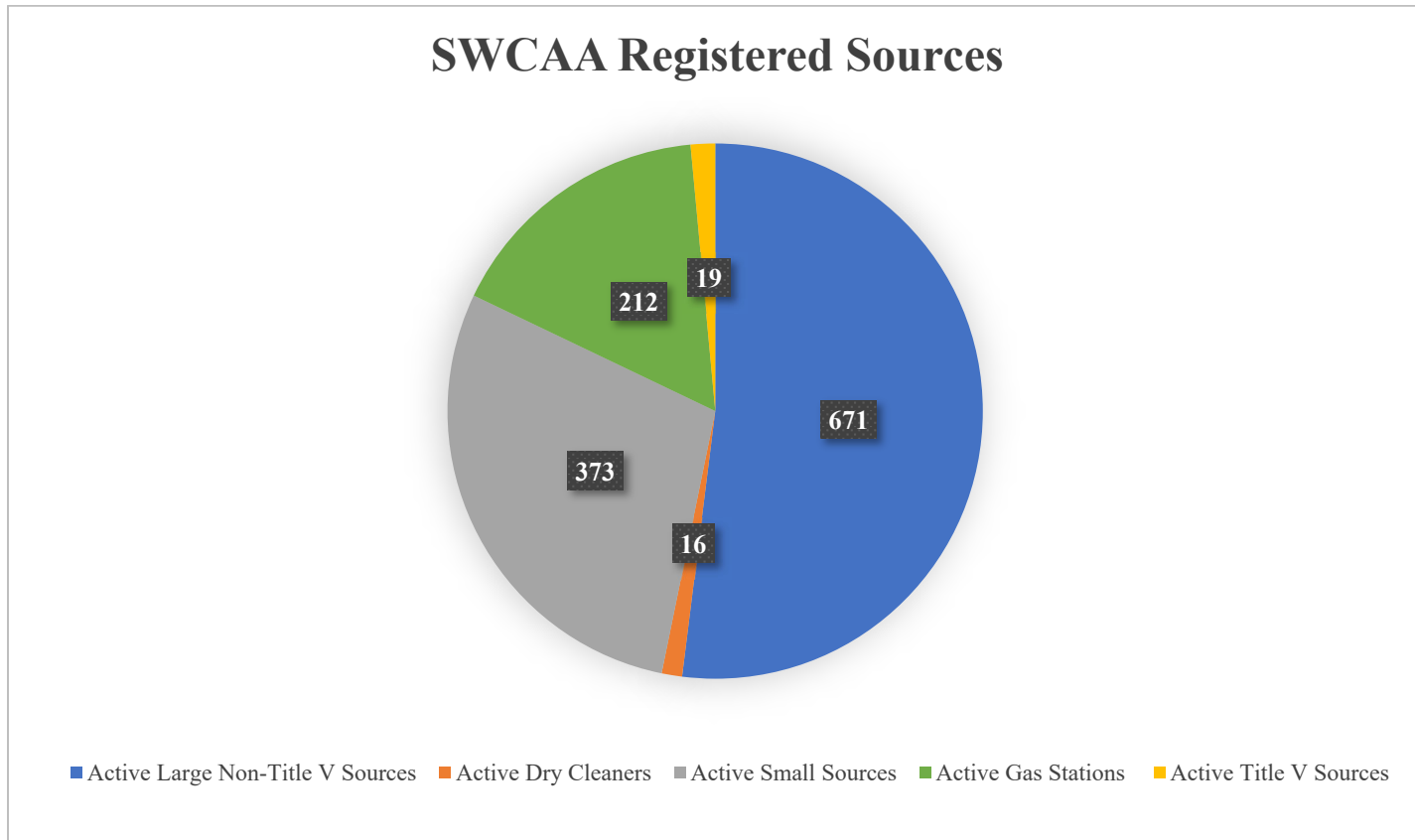
