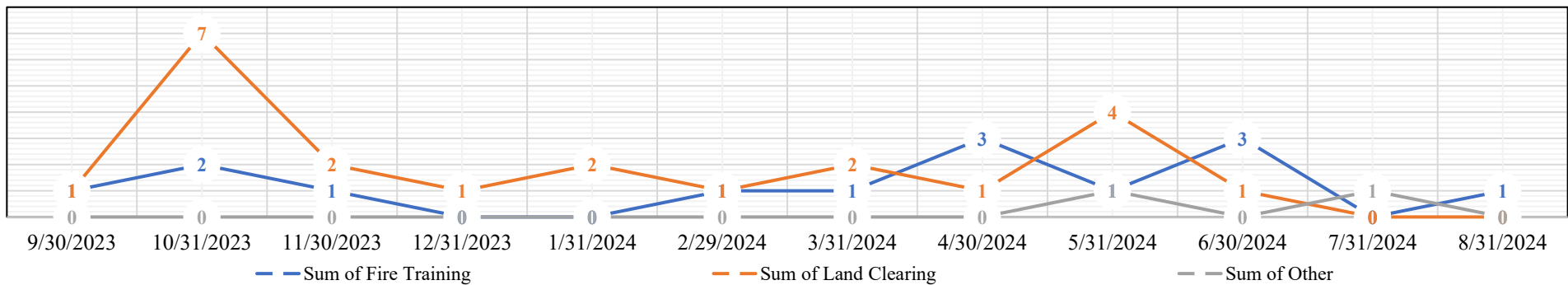

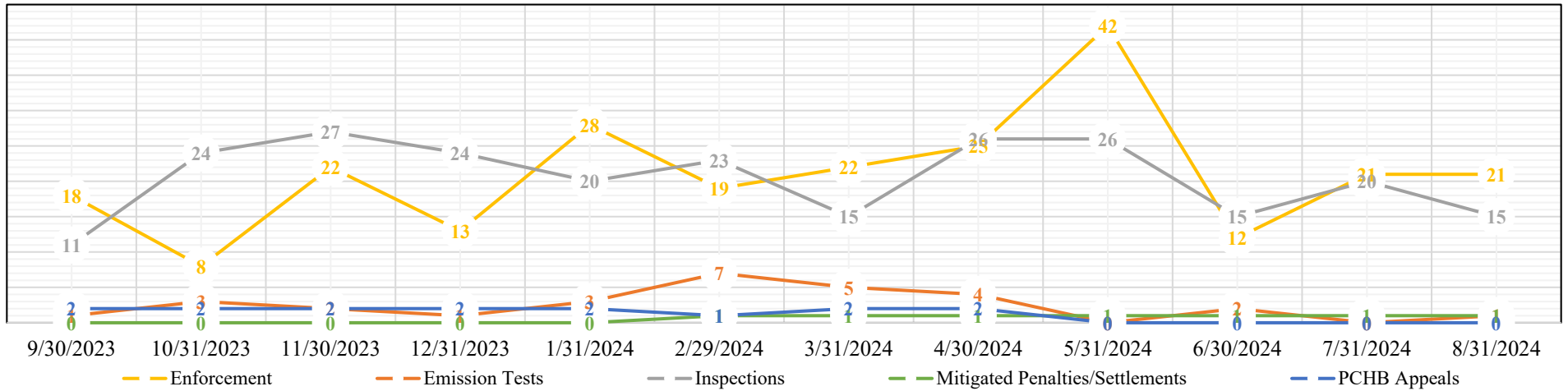

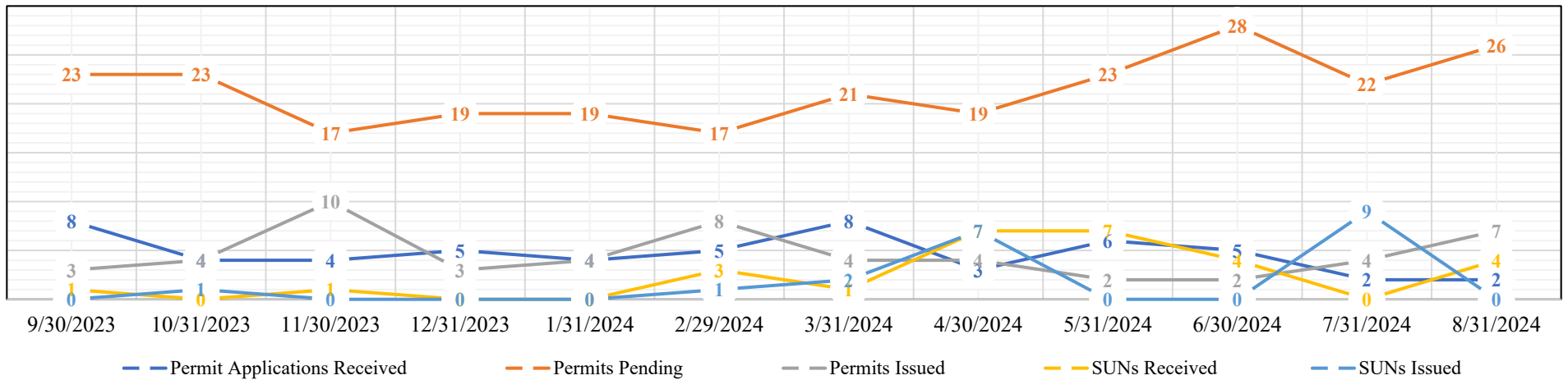

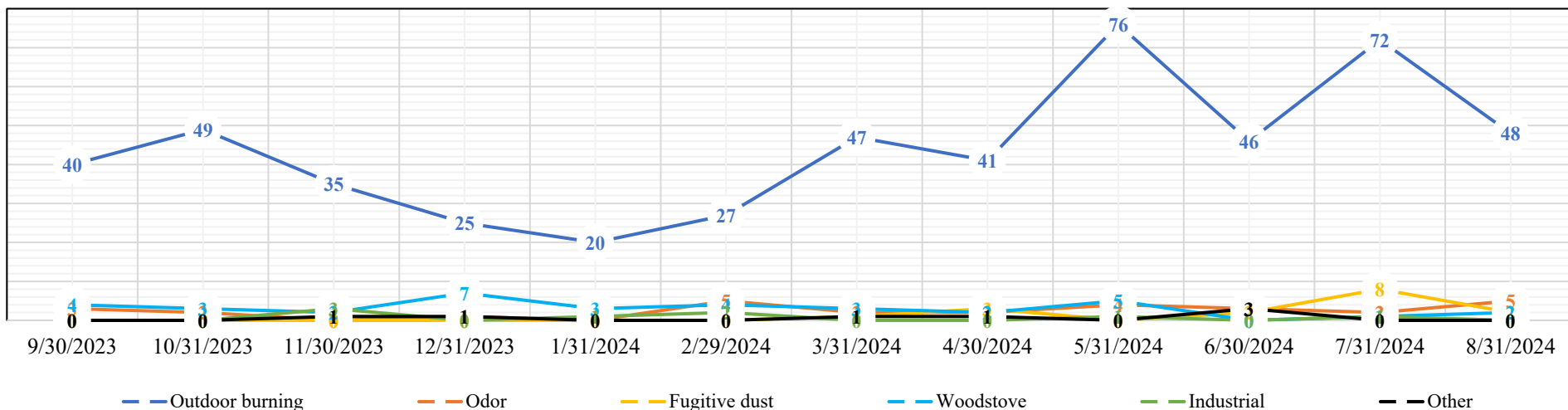


NON-TITLE V New Source Review - Permitting Actions

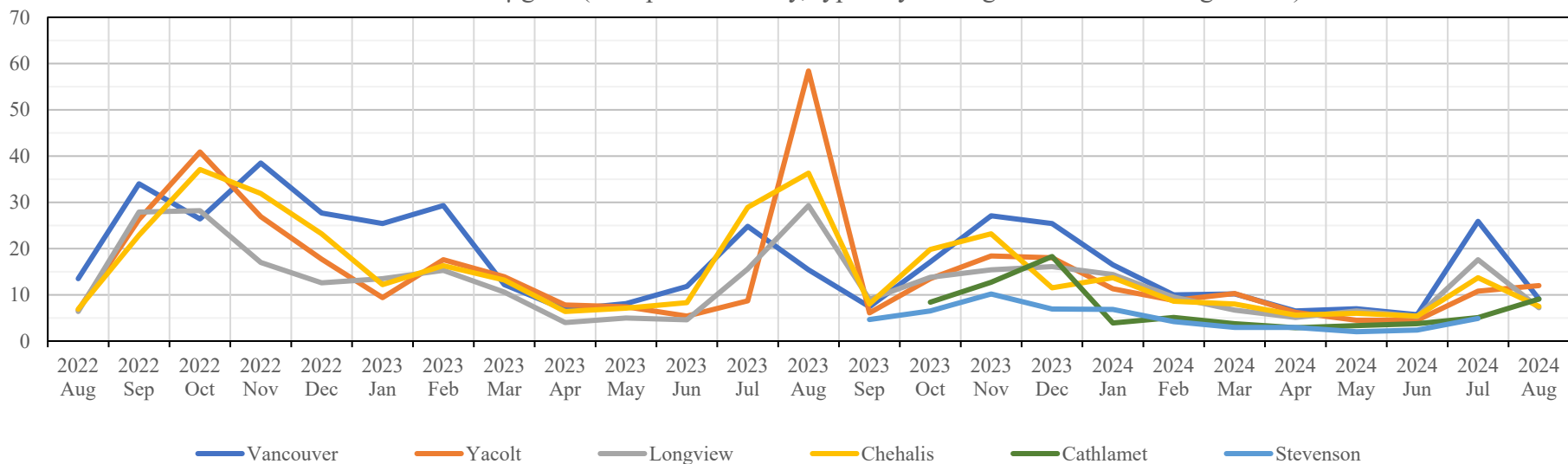


AMBIENT AIR MONITORING DATA

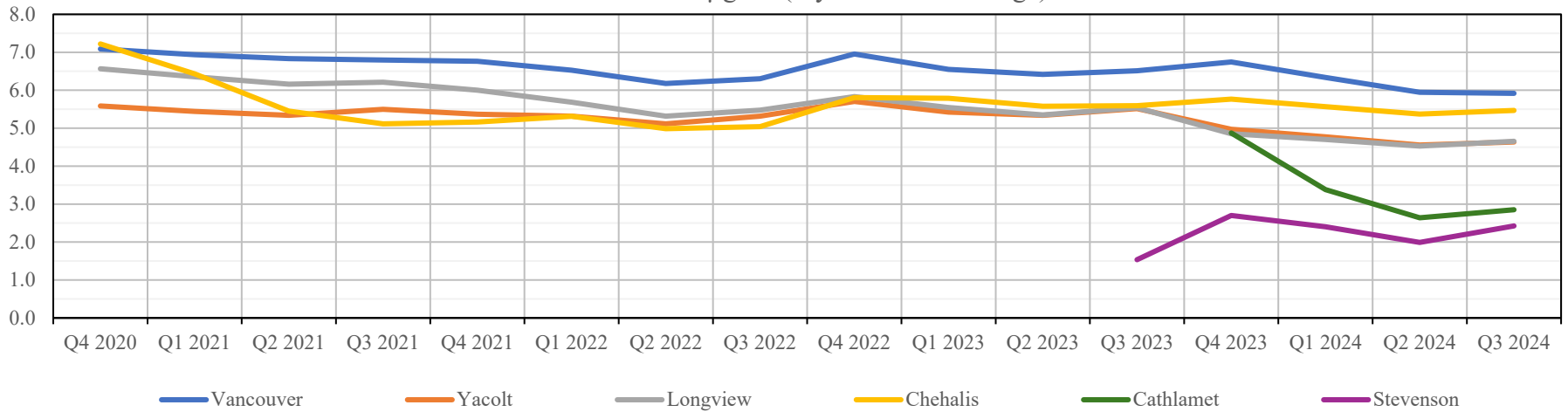
PM_{2.5} - maximum 24 hour average - µg/m³

[excludes flagged wildfire days]

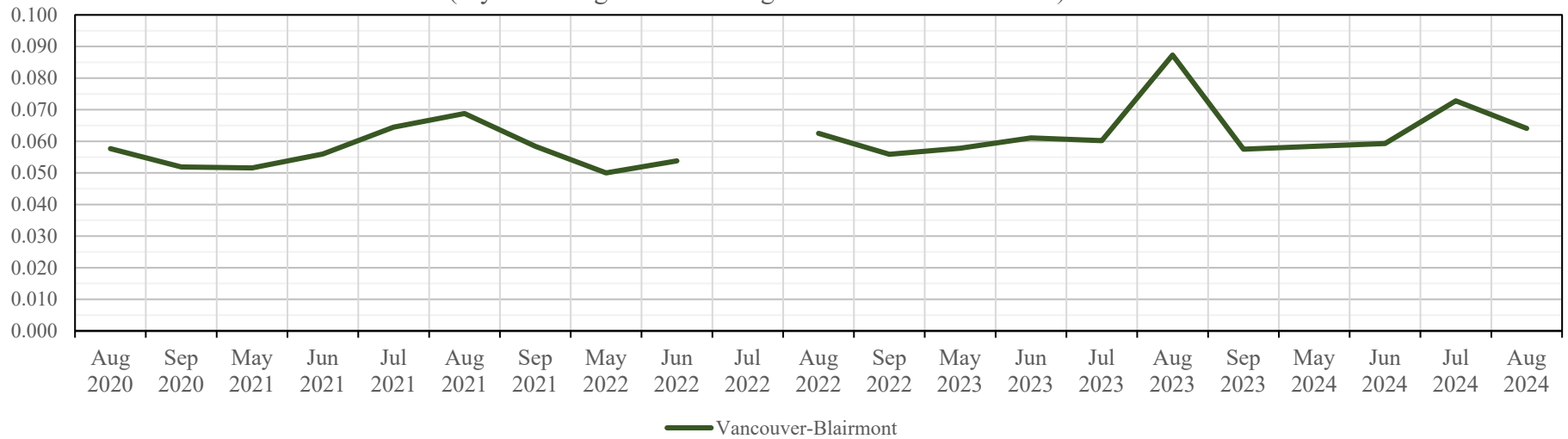
National Standard - 35 µg/m³ (98th percentile day, typically 8th highest 24 hour average value)

 National Standard - 9 $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$ (3-year annual average)



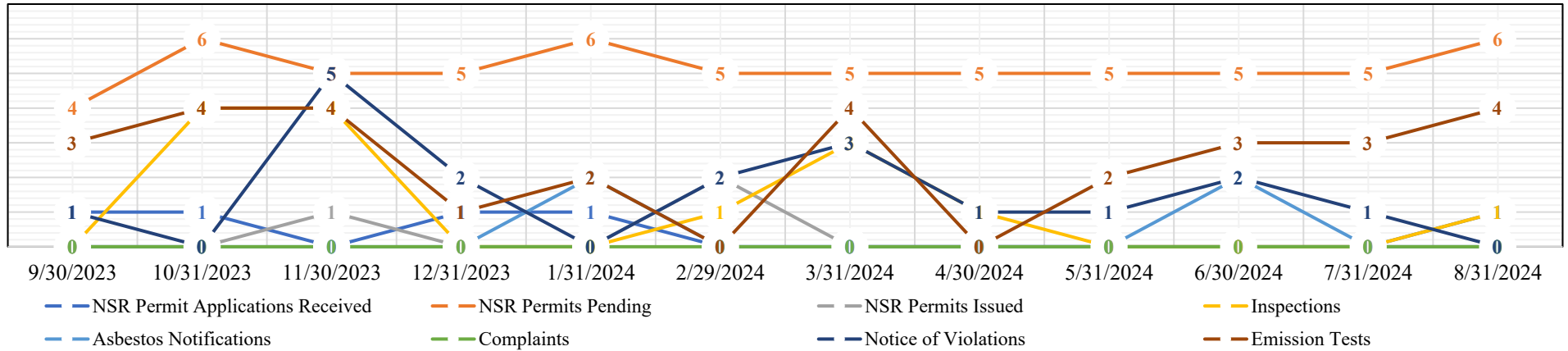
Ozone - Max 8-hour Averages - ppm

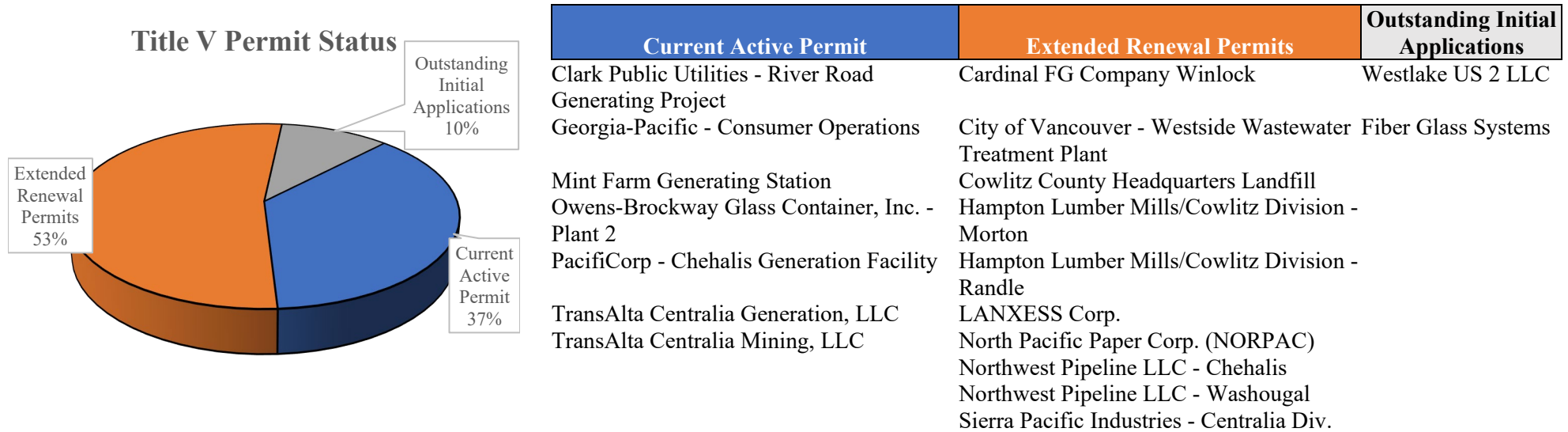

TITLE V Major Industrial Sources



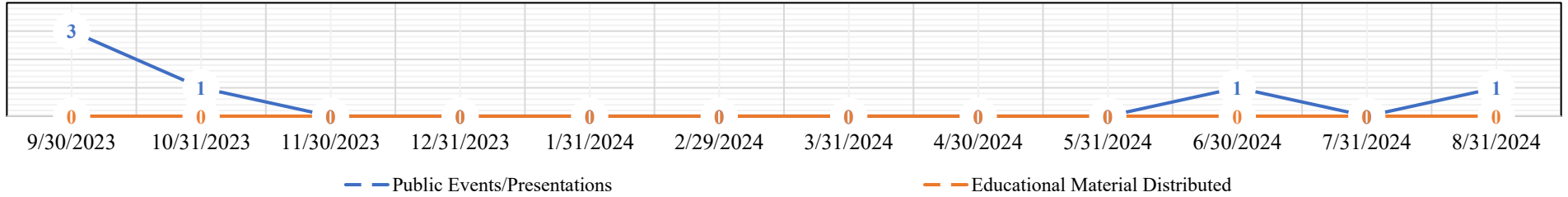

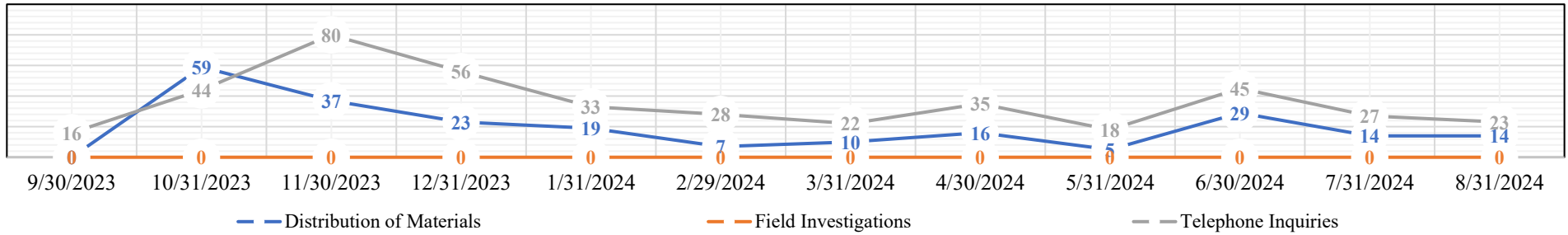

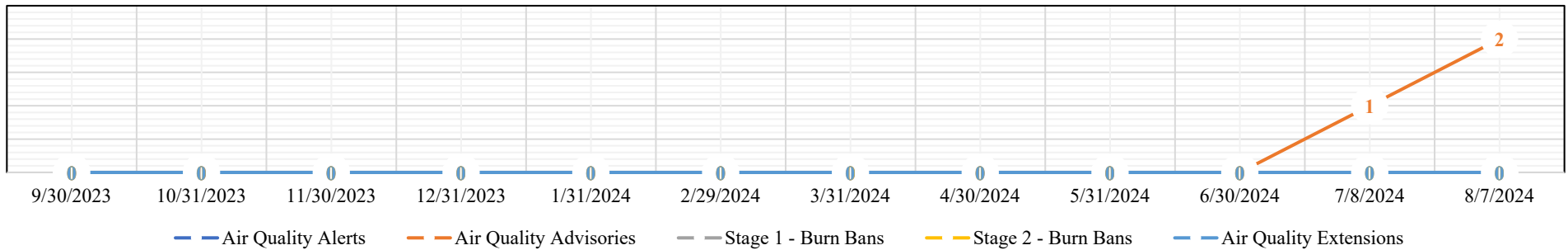

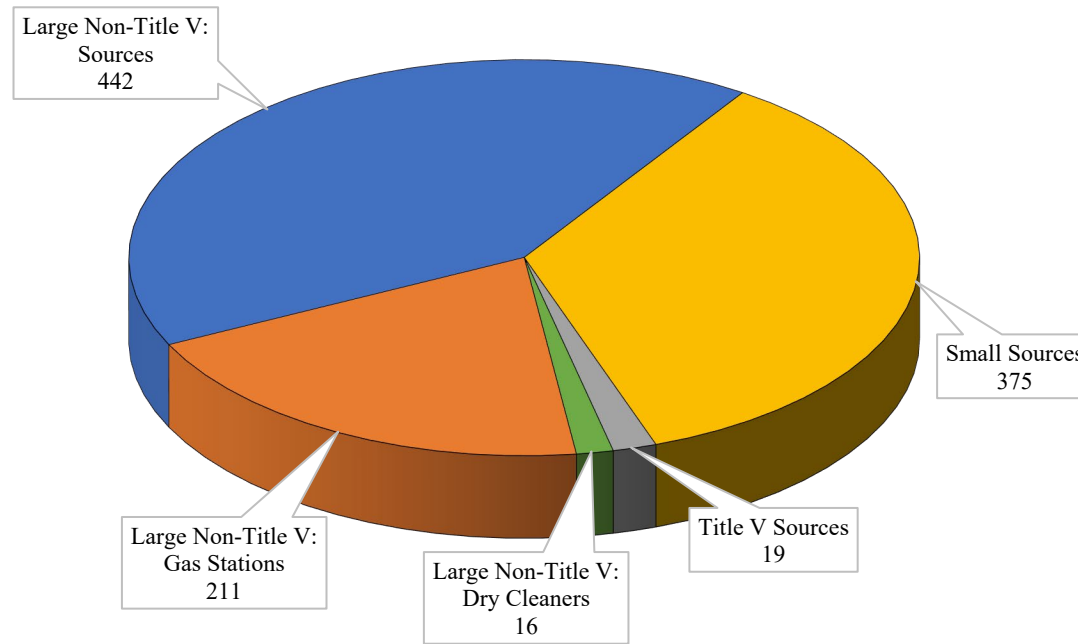
