




NON-TITLE V New Source Review - Permitting Actions



#### AMBIENT AIR MONITORING DATA


# $PM_{2.5}$ - maximum 24 hour average - $\mu g/m^3$

National Standard - 35 µg/m³ (98th percentile day, typically 8th highest 24 hour average value)




#### PM<sub>2.5</sub> - rolling annual averages - µg/m<sup>3</sup>

National Standard - 9 µg/m³ (3-year annual average)



TITLE V - Major Industrial Sources Program Activities




TITLE V - Major Industrial Sources New Source Review - Permitting Actions
