DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 22-030

Description of proposal:

SWCAA 400 Rule Revisions – 2022 General Update. The Southwest Clean Air Agency is proposing to revise SWCAA 400 'General Regulations for Air Pollution Sources' for the purpose of making general revisions, updating incorporation by reference of federal regulations, revise explanation of application and registration fees, move NSR applicability citations for coffee roasters, add minor registration and permitting exemptions, clarify source description in selected sections, revise emission test report requirements, revise permit application completeness criteria, revise NSPS adoptions, and revise severability language. The proposed rule changes do not modify any underlying air quality standards, requirements or regulations in regard to emissions to the ambient air. The proposed rule changes do not affect any media other than air. Adoption of the proposed rule revisions is not expected to have any impact on overall air pollution within the Agency's jurisdiction.
