DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 19-045

Description of proposal:

Rule Changes to SWCAA 476 Standards for Asbestos Control, Demolition and Renovation. The Southwest Clean Air Agency is proposing to revise SWCAA 476 'Standards for Asbestos, Demolition and Renovation'. The proposed rule changes update definitions, remove exemptions, clarify sampling requirements and change terminology. The proposed rule changes do not substantially modify existing standards, requirements or regulations with regards to asbestos regulation. The proposed rule changes do not affect any media other than air. Adoption of the proposed rule revisions is not expected to have any negative impact on overall air pollution within the Agency's jurisdiction.
