DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) – SWCAA 17-006 Description of proposal:

SWCAA Rule Revisions Fee Removal. The Southwest Clean Air Agency is proposing to revise SWCAA 400 'General Regulations for Air Pollution Sources', SWCAA 425 'Outdoor Burning', SWCAA 476 'Standards for Asbestos Control, Demolition, and Renovation', SWCAA 491 'Emission Standards and Controls for Sources Emitting Gasoline Vapors', SWCAA 492 'Oxygenated Fuels', SWCAA 493 'VOC Area Source Rules', and SWCAA 802 'SEPA Procedures' for the purpose of removing reference to individual fee amounts and fee tables. The fees are proposed to be moved to a Consolidated Fee Schedule document that will be posted and available on the SWCAA website. The proposed rule changes do not modify any underlying air quality standards, requirements or regulations in regard to emissions to the ambient air. This change is proposed to consolidate all fees into one location to make them easier to identify on the website and not have to go through the complicated and lengthy rule change process when a fee is updated. The proposed rule changes do not affect any media other than air. Adoption of the proposed rule revisions is not expected to have any impact on overall air pollution within the Agency's jurisdiction.
